We read the story of Jesus weeping at hearing that Lazarus died and talked about how God gave us our feelings. They are not all of us, but are an important part of us.


K4 learned that Jesus felt both sorrow and joy. We finished the story by reading that Jesus rose Lazarus from the dead.
