We began the liturgical season of Lent this week last week with Ash Wednesday. Students learned that Lent is a time to pray, give, and fast for Jesus and for ourselves. K4 students received a mini-book about Lent that will go home next week. Our class has a wreath with toothpicks in it to symbolize Christ's crown of thorns. When a student does something kind, they can remove a "thorn" from the crown as they console the heart of Jesus.
