



GERBER & SONS RECALLS TURKEY FEED DUE TO SUSPECTED NIACIN DEFICIENCY

Baltic, Ohio—September 4, 2026— Gerber & Sons is voluntarily recalling certain lots of turkey feed products due to a suspected niacin deficiency. Possible impacts of niacin deficiency include leg weakness, bowing of the legs, loss of appetite, and decreased growth. Continued feeding of this product may result in serious illness or death in poults and potentially adult birds. If your animals consumed recalled products and have these symptoms, please contact your veterinarian.

This recall is the result of customer reports of animal illnesses received by Gerber & Sons. Gerber & Sons promptly investigated this issue and identified a potential issue regarding niacin deficiency in a third-party vitamin pre-mix added to the affected feed products. No other lot numbers, or feed products manufactured at our facility are affected by this voluntary recall.

Affected lots of feed were manufactured at Gerber’s Baltic, Ohio facility and distributed to dealers and retailers in Ohio between July through August 2026. The recalled products were sold directly to dealers and retailers for further distribution to end-user consumers.

Recalled products were distributed in 50 lb. bags. The affected lot number and manufacturing date can be found printed on the feed bag along the upper right side of the bag. Product lot numbers and manufacture dates of recalled products include:
