Join American Hospital Association's Scott Gee, Deputy National Advisor for Cybersecurity and Risk, veteran of the U.S. Secret Service as he provides his unique national and international perspectives on the latest cyber threats including those arising from geopolitical tensions, third-party providers, and supply chain disruptions. John will discuss how best to prepare for, respond to, and recover from these disruptive cyber-attacks on a local, regional, and national level also providing his insights on the latest cyber legislative and policy developments. John will also offer practical insights tailored to the unique challenges faced by rural hospitals.
