Given the clear direction given by the Order of the Court, the continued breach is regarded with the utmost seriousness and is receiving attention.</i>’</p> <p>Meanwhile fly tipping continues at the entrance making the whole area look terrible. We have asked for this to be cleared. JB suggested contacting the Environment Agency to see if there is any leverage with this. WC said it will be a problem for the new Unitary Authority and will be very costly to resolve the matter.</p> <p>BB advised of a situation of fly tipping in Sidlow, which was observed and recorded and reported to R&BBC. The resident is willing to be a witness but heard nothing further. CB was asked to follow up with JRT team</p> <p>Picketts Lane The upcoming Judicial Review for Plot 2, Picketts Lane is purely about legalities of the enforcement notice. A date is still to be arranged.</p> <p><u>Aviation Matters</u> GACC donation for LGW DCO decision GACC presented at the May Council meeting requesting additional funding to cover costs incurred for legal fees incurred to date. GACC has confirmed they will need to raise further funds if they go to appeal or if they need to defend against either the Sec of State or Gatwick wishing to appeal.</p> <p>Councillors reviewed the request considering historical donations made to GACC from 2020/21 onwards. Councillors agreed to make a donation of £2,500 to GACC.</p> <p><u>Nutfield PC</u> Nutfield Parish Council had reached out to request a meeting to discuss the various proposed developments for the local area to understand how the councils can work together. 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| A | <p><u>Emergency resilience planning</u> This was a follow up meeting for SCC to understand how they can roll out to more areas and ensure all hubs have equipment and process.</p> | |
| B | <p><u>Norwood Hill Res Ass</u> BB said it was frustrating that he was not able to provide a positive update for any of the various sites in Sidlow/ Norwood Hill. No progress was being made on enforcement cases, planning applications, etc.</p> <p>Councillors noted this but said it was beyond the control of the Parish Council and we were monitoring every situation but cannot force a developer to progress their site any quicker.</p> | |
| C | <p><u>NALC legal updates</u> Many legal topics were covered, and CB had shared slides of the meeting. Keys aspects for Councillors to note included: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Changes to the Localism Act S32A – From June 26 councillors addresses should not be shared publicly or on dec of interest. CB will update the noticeboards. ▪ Changes to ACV listings – further update when more known ▪ English Devolution and Communities Empowerment Act 26 did not bring in hybrid meetings so Council meetings must continue to meet face to face. ▪ Rights of Way – S56 of Countryside Rights of Way Act – timeline to have footpaths included in the definitive map has been extended to Jan 2031 (from Jan 26) – so any footpath you know which is out there but not on the Surrey database it can still get recorded. | |
| D | <p><u>R&BBC Planning</u> The meeting focussed on proposed future development of Salfords and Sidlow and government policy on Green belt/ Grey belt review which R&BBC is undertaking. The Green Belt review is time consuming as historically they had concentrated on the areas around the four major towns in the borough. Some areas of R&BBC are within the Surrey Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB), and Banstead area has significant environmental designations, Sites of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) and Local Nature Reserves. This makes S&SPC more susceptible for development.</p> <p>It was agreed that R&BBC would work with S&SPC to have a dialogue on infrastructure requirements, should development progress and for Parish Councillors to advise what is needed and wanted dependent upon size of a development. It was imperative to understand water supply, waste services, roads, public transport, education, doctors, dentists, hospitals, etc.</p> <p>CB advised that in the early 2000's when R&BBC knew that expansion and development for Horley was proposed with around 2,500 new homes, the Horley Master plan was developed and focused on creating major new neighbourhoods, infrastructure, schools, open space, and town centre improvements. It was about creating a larger, more sustainable area rather than simply adding housing estates. and cycle links from the new neighbourhoods into the centre. One of the key monitoring mechanisms was the Horley Regeneration Forum which brought together R&BBC, HTC, S&SPC, Developers, SCC, other infrastructure providers and community</p> | |

His dedication and commitment to representing the interests of the community were widely recognised.</p> <p>Elaine Buckland was a valued member of the train station team and contributed to many community initiatives, including litter picks, tree and daffodil planting projects. More recently, she managed the book swap store at the train station, which was greatly appreciated by local residents.</p> <p>The Parish Council expressed its condolences to their families and friends and acknowledged with gratitude the lasting contribution both Chris and Elaine made to the parish.</p> <p>The Parish Councillors also extended their best wishes to resident John, one of the parish's community litter pickers, for a full and speedy recovery.</p> | |

Steve Wotton and Andrew Stevens, both Liberal Democrats, were elected for this area. The Liberal Democrats secured 40 of the 72 seats available meaning it holds the majority. | |
