The monthly meeting of the Holland Patent Village Board was called to order at 7 pm by Mayor Furlong. In attendance were Trustees Brucker, Mann, McCann and Rosenburgh, Codes Officer Boulerville, Wastewater Superintendent West and Clerk/Treasurer Taylor. Visitors were Renee Hughes and John Healt.

A motion was made by Trustee McCann, seconded by Trustee Man to approve the minutes from the January meeting. CARRIED

Renee Hughes addressed the Board with concerns regarding her mailbox being blocked by cars of patrons at a nearby business. Codes Officer explained that there isn't anything the Village can do correct the situation. He did offer possible solutions to Ms. Hughes.
John Healt delivered NOCCOG announcements.

Codes Officer presented the Board with information regarding an up coming training. Motion by Trustee Brucker, seconded by Trustee McCann to approve the training. CARRIED

Wastewater Superintendent gave a status report and said the new panel is working well.

Trustee Rosenburgh asked that minutes from meetings be placed in pdf form.

Trustee Mann reported on bands for the summer concert in the park.

Trustee McCann reported on Wadas grand for playground equipment. She asked if the Village has any money set aside to help offset costs. Trustee Rosenburgh does not think this is a responsible use of taxpayer money.

Trustee Brucker is waiting on a quote from McQuade & Bannigan for no parking signs.

The Treasurer's report was presented for review. Motion to accept the Treasurer's report and make it a matter of record by Trustee Mann, seconded by Trustee McCann. CARRIED The Treasurer asked for a motion to transfer \$600.00 from A1990.4 to A1620.1. Motion by Trustee Brucker, seconded by Trustee McCann. CARRIED The Treasurer asked for a motion to transfer \$7000.00 from A1990.4 to A7140.4. Motion by Trustee Mann, seconded by Trustee Brucker. CARRIED

The Clerk presented the General Audit for review. Motion to approve the General Audit by Trustee Mann, seconded by Trustee McCann. CARRIED The Wastewater Audit was presented. Motion to approve the Wastewater Audit by Trustee McCann, seconded by Trustee Brucker. CARRIED The Clerk asked for a motion to approve Evelyn Clark and Bonnie Churcher as election inspectors for the upcoming Village elections. Motion by Trustee Rosenburgh, seconded by Trustee McCann. CARRIED

The Mayor said the money given to the DAR will not be used for the original purpose. The DAR has an alternative use for it. The Board decided they would like the money returned.

Motion to adjourn the meeting made by Trustee McCann, seconded by Trustee Brucker. CARRIED Meeting adjourned at 8:15 pm.
