## **A New Chapter for Lynnhaven School: Daniela Fenwick Selected as Head of School**

Fenwick brings nearly 30 years of experience in education, family engagement, and nonprofit leadership. An immigrant from Porto Alegre, Brazil, she has dedicated her career to strengthening school-family partnerships and building inclusive, supportive learning communities. She currently serves as a Center Director with YWCA Richmond, where she oversees operations and family engagement across multiple school locations.

“From the beginning, our community was clear about what Lynnhaven needs in this moment: a leader who listens deeply, builds trust, and brings steady, people-centered leadership,” said Dr. Courtney Hughes-Harris, Vice President of the Board of Trustees and Chair of the Head of School Search Committee. “Mrs. Fenwick stood out at every stage of the process because she aligns with those priorities in both her values and her track record. We are confident she will strengthen partnerships with families, support faculty, and lead with the calm clarity our students deserve.”

“I am deeply honored to join the Lynnhaven community and excited to walk alongside students, families, educators, and alumni,” Fenwick said. “Lynnhaven’s commitment to student-centered learning and meaningful relationships deeply resonates with me, and I look forward to contributing to the school’s next chapter.”

Fenwick will be formally introduced to the Lynnhaven community at a Meet & Greet on January 23, 2026, and will begin transitioning into the role this spring. She will officially assume Head of School responsibilities in July 2026. She succeeds Mrs. Bernadett Carter, who has served as Interim Head of School since January 2025.
