practice? Seriously, I get all types of reactions when people are suddenly trapped behind me. They throw their hands into the air, violently shake their head or pound their steering wheels. If they can make it around me, they frequently honk or offer a one finger wave. I gleefully wave at them as we are stopped side by side at the next traffic signal. They're seldom amused.

I suppose what saddens me most about these exchanges is just how easily the other person, willingly hands over their freedom, by their reaction. We are not created to be slaves to this type of behavior.
