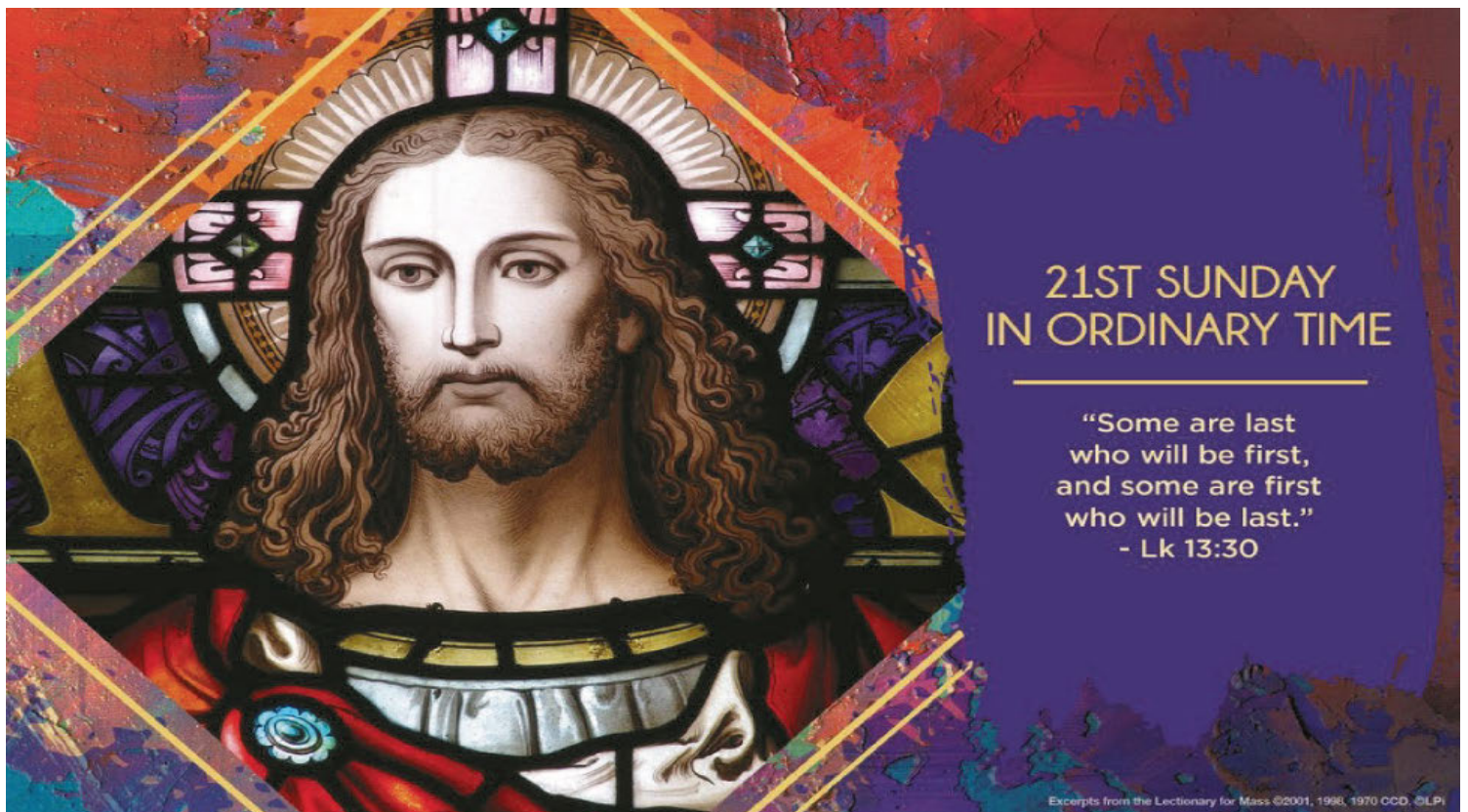



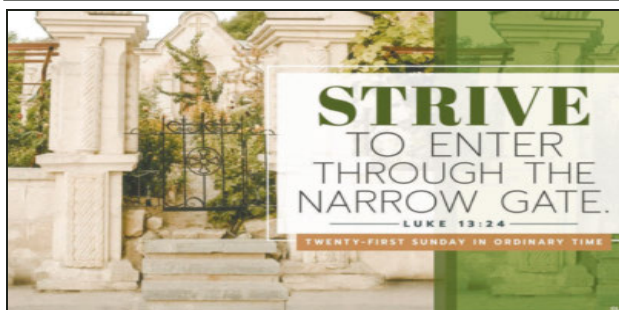

On Our Journey

Being a Communications instructor, my faith message includes daily taking that "silent" time Fr. Ryan encourages. Reflect and write as everyone has a faith journey message and your words, big or small, can touch someone's life.

In 1999 - 2004, I lived and worked in Saudi Arabia, a Muslim country. The Christians on the compound gathered on Friday nights (which was equivalent to our Sundays --- their weekends are Thursday and Friday). We often prayed together, shared joys and struggles, and read and studied scripture.

One year, I worked in an Arab women high school where I was required to stand in the auditorium every morning at 7 AM with all students and teachers, and "listen" to the Koran prayers recited for twenty-five minutes. Believe it or not, it was at that time that I grew very close to Our Lord Jesus Christ. Not knowing more than a few phrases in Arabic, that time allowed me to speak and listen to God and share all my heart.

Silent times, like Fr. Ryan says, it is hard to find in today's world. Consider that even while I was hearing a foreign tongue over a loudspeaker, Our God heard my fever and love for Him. He hears us through all the "noise" anytime we decide to focus on Him.

Our world is rampant with activity. Even in the hustle and bustle of our days, we can create those silent spaces. Selective hearing is God's creation, the whisper of the birds in the morning instead of the hum of the road traffic. Or using earbuds listening to Sacred Music for five minutes on the Relevant Radio app -- the Glory of God is here, close to each of us.

I thank my parents for baptizing me in the Catholic Church and our regular Sunday attendance which certainly planted enough seeds for me to choose to grow in my faith and love of Lord Jesus Christ. I share my Mass attendance at St. Peter and Paul, and slowly getting to know more parishioners at St. John's and St. Francis Cathedral. Praying for all of you too.
