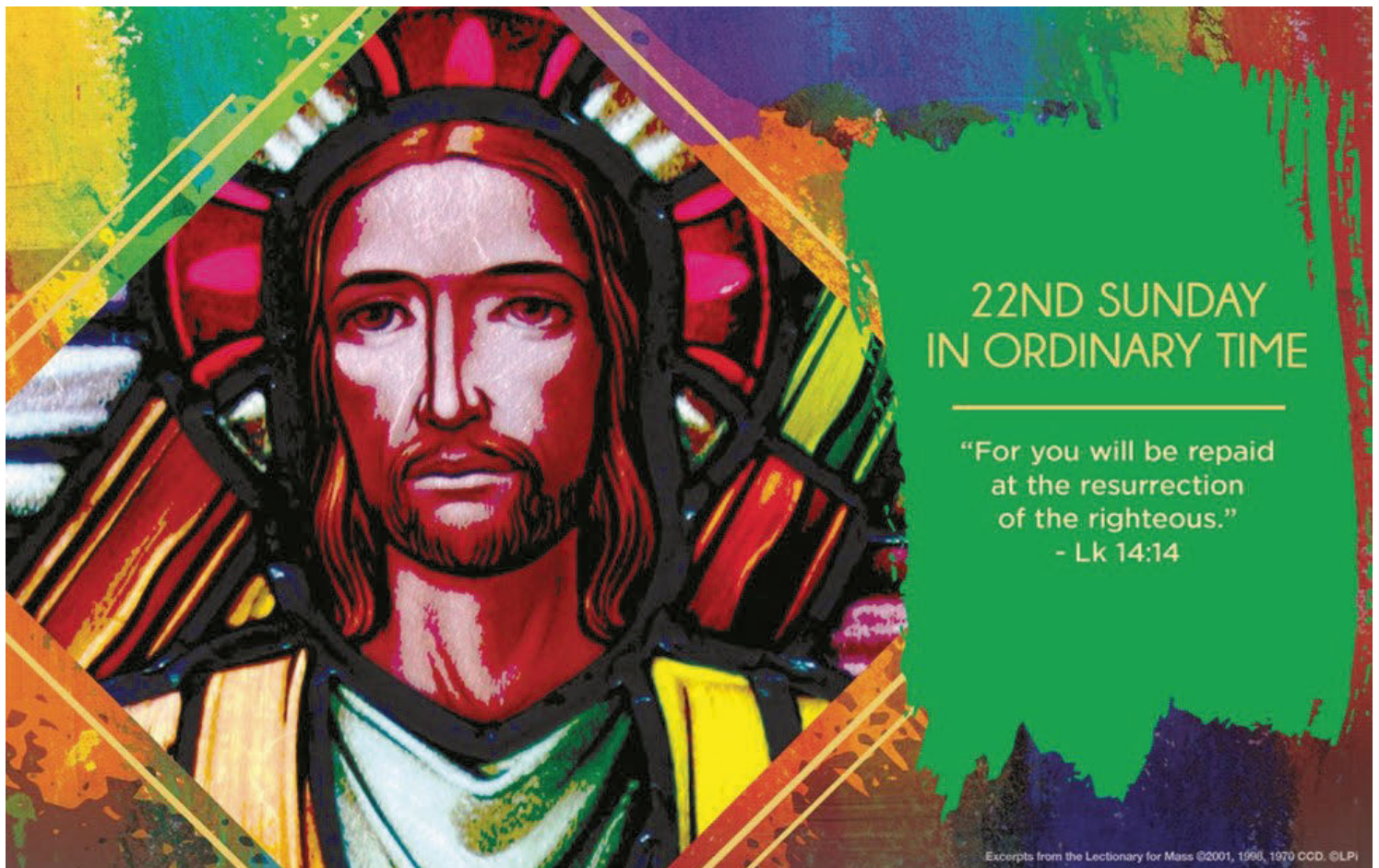

## Bishop Ricken's September Intention

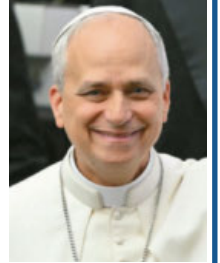
### For Catechists and all those who hand on the faith:

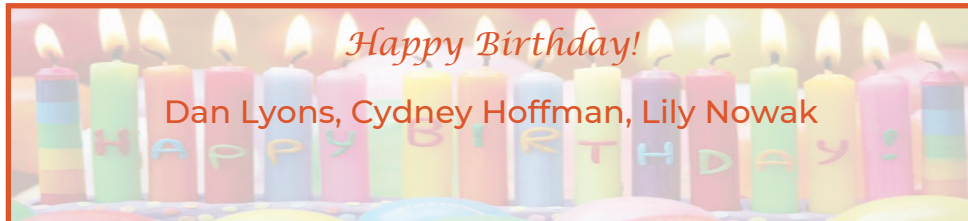

We all know the beatitudes, we have heard them all our lives. Matthew 5:3-12.

Blessed are the poor in spirit, those who mourn, the meek, those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, the merciful, the clean of heart, the peacemakers, the persecuted for righteousness, when you are insulted and persecuted for God, we should rejoice for our reward will be great in heaven.

But do we live the beatitudes? I had a wonderful teacher who called them Be-attitudes. What is our attitude as we read each verse? Can we have the be-attitude God is asking us to have? Can we 'be' -

The Beatitudes are not just nice thoughts from the Bible, they are action words. They are asking us to take action. We have the power in God to take the Beatitudes and make them our Be-attitudes. To 'Be' the person God wants us to be.
