





### NOTES

### from the Director of Music, Michael J. Miller

Dear Cathedral Family,

As we transition into the autumnal weeks of Ordinary Time, I want to alert you to a shift that will be happening with some of our music here at the Cathedral.

Beginning the weekend of September 28, we will change musical settings for the Ordinary of the Mass (Kyrie, Gloria, Sanctus, Agnus Dei) and will be singing these movements in Latin. One of the great misconceptions of the Second Vatican Council is that it sought to do away with the use of Latin. In reality, nothing could be further from the truth! Yes, the use of vernacular language is the norm in the United States, "for the sake of a better comprehension of the mystery being celebrated" as the General Instruction of the Roman Missal explains. But Sacrosanctum Concilium also instructs that pastors should ensure "that the faithful may also be able to say or to sing together in Latin those parts of the Ordinary of the Mass which pertain to them." The Church's vision when it comes to language is not an either/or, but a both/and.

I encourage you to use these weeks to hone your familiarity and comfort with these ancient texts. Open yourself to the beauty of the Latin language and its rich and lengthy history as the principal tongue of the Roman Catholic Church. Allow it to stir your heart and mind, and to draw you more deeply into the universal prayers of the Church.

In my experience, the Gloria is the most challenging movement for parishioners to gain mastery over, simply because it is the longest. On the back side of this page you will find the text of the Gloria. I encourage you to take this home and practice it. Read the text aloud, pondering each phrase, and allowing the sound, feel, and rhythm of the words to establish themselves more confidently on your tongue. This simple "homework" assignment will reap great spiritual dividends when we enter into the sacred mysteries together.

The letter "e" will always make a short *e* sound, as in *mellow*. It will not shift to the long *e* sound, as it does in *obey*.


Wednesday, October 1st and Wednesday, October 8th, the 8:30AM Mass will be at St. John the Evangelist.
