

A beautiful Advent Tradition - Bambinelli Sunday

Bambinelli Sunday is a beautiful tradition that was started by Pope St. John Paul II. Bambinelli is Italian, the plural of bambinello which means "little baby [boy]." Bambinelli Sunday is celebrated on Gaudete Sunday, the third Sunday of Advent. Thousands of people come to St. Peter's Square bringing the Baby Jesus figurines from their creches and nativity scenes; then, at the time of the Pope's Angelus address, he blesses all the little figures of the Child Jesus. Families also traditionally spend their Advent season making small sacrifices or doing good deeds for the Child Jesus, represented by adding a piece of straw to His manger for each good deed performed. When Christmas day arrives, the Baby Jesus is placed in the empty creche made comfortable by these acts of charity.

In the spirit of this tradition, families, you are invited to bring the baby Jesus figurine from your home creche to be blessed at Mass on the **weekend of December 13-14th.**

On Our Journey

O come Emmanuel. If you attended the Sunday morning Mass at the Cathedral on the first Sunday of Advent, you would have heard Bishop Ricken's homily, which included him explaining the three comings of Christ. For those who weren't there or others who would like a little reminder, here is a brief summary. The first coming of Christ was his incarnation, when he came into the world as a baby in Bethlehem around 2,000 years ago. The second coming of Christ was when we (each one of us) accepted Jesus into our hearts. We moved from knowing of Jesus to knowing him personally. And the last or third coming of Christ will be at the end of time (Parousia) when the world ends and time and space give way to eternity. I wish to expand on his sermon on the comings of Christ. Perhaps the coming of Christ that is preeminent in our minds is the moment when we die, and we see Jesus face-to-face for the first time, and our eternal destiny is determined. To me, that is something we should keep in the forefront of our minds. Another coming of Christ we may overlook is when he enters our lives daily. My guess is we don't often think about this because we are caught up in the busyness of everyday life, especially during the Advent season. We use words like hope, joy, and gratitude, but do we acknowledge that those realities in our lives are graces given to us by God? Graces he sees we need in our lives, and he knows we need them because that's how close he is to us every day. We need to be aware of the epic moments when Jesus has and will come, but let's also keep in mind that he is with us always.
