






Most Reverend Robert J. Banks, Bishop Emeritus of Green Bay, born February 26th, 1928 in Boston, MA has passed away peacefully on Sunday, January 25th, 2026. Bishop Banks was 97 years old and has been a priest for 73 years, and a Bishop for 40 years. At the time of his death, he was among the nation's oldest Bishops. He was ordained to the priesthood at Rome's Lateran Basilica on December 20th, 1952.

Bishop Banks was appointed Bishop of the Diocese in Green Bay on December 5th, 1990 and installed as the 10th Bishop of the Diocese.

Please pray for the repose of the soul of Bishop Robert J. Banks who was an outstanding shepherd of the flock entrusted to his care.


