

On Our Journey.....to the “Little Way”

In response to Bishop Ricken’s most recent Pastoral Letter, I took some time to reflect on the life of Saint Thérèse of Lisieux, the Little Flower.

Thérèse was born in Alençon, France on January 2, 1873. She was the youngest of nine children. Four of her siblings died at very young ages. When she was four, her mother died of breast cancer and her older sister Pauline became like her second mother. When Thérèse was 10, Pauline entered the Carmelite Convent, leaving her with further feelings of abandonment.

The youth of Thérèse, indeed most of her life was filled with much suffering. An often-used quote from her states, “Sufferings gladly borne for others convert more people than sermons.”

At the age of 23, Thérèse began coughing blood which would later be diagnosed as tuberculosis. She died just 5 months later at the age of 24.

At a ceremony in 1997, Pope John Paul II announced that she had been declared a Doctor of the Church. She is 1 of only 3 great, women Saints who have been given the title, and she is the youngest of all the Doctors of the Church.

Her “Little Way” is known throughout the world. She herself said “You know well enough that our Lord does not look so much at the greatness of our actions, nor even at their difficulty, but at the love at which we do them.” She perfected her life in the many small and ordinary acts of life including laundry, chopping vegetables, promptly responding to the call of others, and keeping a cheerful face despite adversity. I look forward to learning more about St. Thérèse and better living her “Little Way”.


