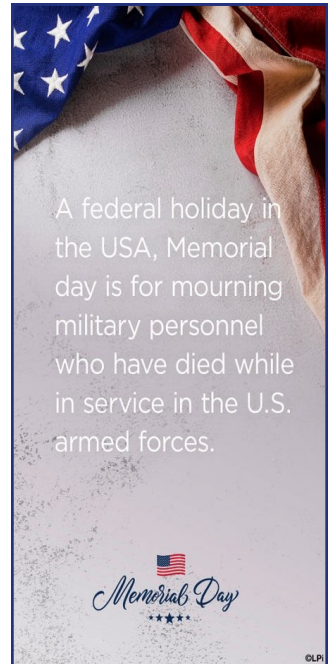

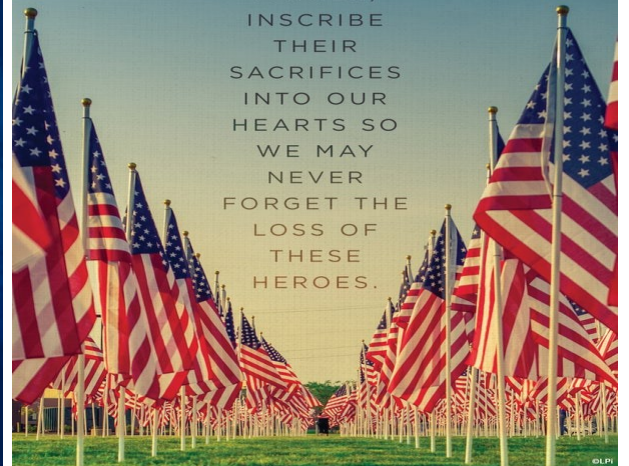
"Look on the flower, think of Mary." SFX Cathedral's Mary's Garden isn't just a garden. It began over 19 years ago, and was dedicated to Mary, the Mother of God, by Msgr. Roy Klister in August 23, 2008. The statue of Our Lady of Lourdes was originally from the grotto at St. Joseph's Catholic Girls School (now Aldo Leopold). Our Mary Garden and Rosary Garden plants were researched using literature and correspondence with John Stokes, Jr., who led the American Mary Garden Movement in the 1950s. Vincenzina Krymow, author of "Mary's Flowers, Gardens, Legends and Meditations" was also instrumental in planning the SFX Mary Garden & Rosary Garden. Landscape architects were hired, along with Master Gardeners, horticulturalists, arborists and parish members with extensive plant expertise. Our plants were chosen carefully by these experts, from the list of plants with Marian names given to them by St. Francis of Assisi and medieval monks, the original Mary Gardeners. (A statue represents St. Francis in our garden.) St. Francis shared legends about the plants to teach illiterate people about Jesus and Our Lady. One legend tells that the angel Gabriel held a lily (Madonna Lily) in his hand when he came to tell Mary that she would give birth to Jesus. After Mary touched the flower, which had been scentless, an exquisite fragrance arose from it. Flowers were said to spring from the earth wherever Mary walked. The use of color in the Rosary Garden also reminds us of Mary - White for the Joyful Mysteries, Red for the Sorrowful Mysteries, Yellow for the Glorious Mysteries and Purple for the Luminous Mysteries. The planting and cultivation of a Mary's Garden fosters devotion to Mary that always leads to Christ. Youth Faith Formation/Sacramental Preparation

Registration is now open for the 2026-27 faith formation year. All classes including Catechesis of the Good Shepherd atrium sessions are held on Wednesdays September through May. For planning purposes, please register as soon as possible. To avoid a late fee, please register no later than June 15th.

All Class offerings are held at St. Francis Xavier Cathedral site:

- Weekly Youth Faith Formation classes for children in grades 1-12
- Weekly Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Level 1 atrium session (ages 3-6). Please note, due to limited space in the atrium, priority will be given to families who have parish membership here at the Cathedral and St. John the Evangelist Parishes.
- Confirmation classes held separately in the spring of 2027
- First Confession/Holy Communion Preparation Classes

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION:

***First Confession and Holy Communion:** For children entering second grade or an older child who has not received these sacraments. **Important note: Children who attend Catholic Day School seeking to prepare for these sacraments need to register now for part time classes at the parish (see separate part time schedule on Cathedral website).**

Confirmation:** **Please note an important change for Confirmation registration. We will only accept registrations from families who have parish membership at Cathedral or St. John the Evangelist Parishes.**

Teens in public, parochial, and home school seeking the sacrament of Confirmation MUST REGISTER NOW for classes held in the spring of 2027.
