

The Carleton Funeral Home Co-Operative Scholarship 2026

The Carleton Funeral Home Co-Operative Scholarship is valued at \$2000 and will be awarded annually to one student graduating from one of the following high schools:

- Carleton North High School
- Hartland Community School
- Woodstock High School
- Canterbury High School
- Home school candidates (see note on application form)

Eligibility Criteria:

- The student will be enrolled in a post-secondary program of studies of at least 2 years duration.
- The student will display leadership in academics and in a variety of extra-curricular activities during his/her high school years.
- The student has proven to be a positive role model for others by their character and generosity to others.
- Financial need is not a requirement, but may be a consideration.

Applications must be submitted to your School Counsellor by **March 31, 2026**.

Application Procedure: (students must include the following)

- Completed application.
- Official high school transcript.
- Letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach or other mentor.
- This application should be accompanied by a one page letter outlining your goals and aspirations for the future, reasons why you would be a deserving recipient of this scholarship and the *value of co-operatives in your community*.

The Scholarship Committee at each high school listed above will meet to review the applications and select one student. These names will be forwarded to the committee at the Carleton Funeral Home and one student will be selected. The school counsellor will be contacted with the name of the student that has been selected at this level.

The scholarship will be announced at graduation and awarded upon proof of acceptance for term two of year one.
