This session will also help you develop a strategic plan for your committee so they can develop goals and projects. After this session you will know how to take your committee to the next level, from discussing safety issues to solving those issues.

11:00-Noon "Create an Effective Lockout Tagout Program" | Gary Leshovsky | OECS

Creating a strong Lockout/Tagout (LOTO) program is critical to preventing injuries caused by the unexpected release of hazardous energy during equipment maintenance. This course is designed for safety leaders, supervisors, and maintenance personnel who play a key role in implementing or supporting LOTO procedures.

Participants will learn how to develop and sustain a compliant, effective program by understanding the requirements of OSHA Standard 1910.147, defining roles for affected and authorized employees, and applying proper lockout/tagout techniques.

The course also addresses how to manage outside contractors and ensure the correct use of tags and devices. Whether you're building a new program or strengthening an existing one, this course will help you protect workers and avoid costly incidents.

JHA and JSA: The Same Thing? Is There a Difference?


JHA (Job Hazard Analysis) and JSA (Job Safety Analysis) are often used interchangeably, but they have distinct focuses and approaches in workplace safety.
