



Summary Committee Report from the Committee Meeting held on Tuesday 12th May 2026.

The Committee met on 12th May 2026 at High Legh Village Hall.

Treasurer's Report:

- The Centre finances continue to run as normal.
- It was agreed that additional support and training would be beneficial for newer Rally Officers to help with financial reporting processes.

Rally Programme:

- Twenty rallies have been held so far this year, with strong demand and several reaching full capacity.
- Forty-one rallies remain in the 2026 programme.
- Planning for the 2027 rally programme is progressing well.
- Membership checks for Rally Officers continue to ensure compliance with Centre requirements.

Officers Reports:

- West Central Division (WCD) Shropshire rally was expanded to more units and is now full.
- Webmaster reported ongoing updates, maintenance, and online booking activity and website use remains strong.
- Rally Promotions: rally reports being added monthly; work ongoing to engage new ralliers and rally officers.
- Minor equipment issues had been identified and resolved with some routine repairs and maintenance.
- Four sports events have been held successfully so far this season. The next event will take place at the Junior Rally.

Defibrillators on rallies

The Committee reviewed the topic following a member enquiry. After discussion, it was agreed that providing defibrillators on all rallies is not currently practical due to cost, logistics and maintenance considerations. Members should continue to follow emergency procedures, call 999 and make use of local public defibrillators where available.
