## **Medicaid Team**

- State employees and contracted specialty vendors
  - Medicaid staff are assigned to one of four bureaus (teams) based on specific skills and interests
    - Managed Care Bureau
      - MCO oversight, contracting, quality and reporting
    - Operations Bureau
      - Vendor contracts, pharmacy, program integrity
    - Eligibility Policy Bureau
      - Member eligibility and HIPP policy
    - Medical and Long-Term Services and Supports (LTSS)
      - Connections to the work of the DD Council



## **Medicaid Specialty Vendors**

- Contracted vendors
  - Bulk of Medicaid team (400+) are vendor staff
    - Member Services
    - Provider Services
    - Provider Cost Audit and Rate Setting
    - Program Integrity
    - Quality Improvement Organization (QIO)
    - Revenue and Collections
    - CORE
    - Pharmacy



## **Medical and LTSS Policy**

- Responsible for policy development for several programs
  - Medicaid (including all Medical and LTSS/HCBS programs)
  - CHIP Children's Health Insurance Program
  - Hawki Healthy and Well Kids in Iowa
  - IHWP Iowa Health and Wellness Program
    - also known as Medicaid expansion



## **Medical and LTSS Policy**

- Responsible for establishing and maintaining Medicaid policies related to medical and long-term services and supports
  - Hospitals, physicians, clinics, behavioral health, substance use disorder, durable medical equipment, etc.
  - Monitor federal regulations to make sure we are following the rules
  - Develop and update state plan amendments (SPAs)
  - Develop and update federal waiver applications
  - Develop, monitor and update administrative rules
  - Develop and submit reports to legislators and federal government
  - Work with advocacy groups, members, families, associations, legislators to address policies to make programs successful
  - Quality Oversight of all Medicaid, CHIP and IHWP programs
  - Technical Assistance for all programs
  - HCBS waiver slot management
  - Money Follows the Person (MFP)
  - Managed Care Oversight and collaboration

#### Strategic Planning

- Adding additional reserved capacity waiver slots

#### Pandemic Response:

- Make sure everyone has access to vaccines
- Public Health Emergency (PHE) Unwind
  - We have a lot of policies we still need to work out
  - Identify flexibilities we want to keep (such as telehealth)

#### Listening Sessions - identify issues and resolutions

- Member and provider townhalls
- Durable Medical Equipment (DME) and Prior Authorization
- Maternal Health
- School-Based Services
- Transition Aged Services
- Consumer Choice Option (CCO) workgroup

- ARPA Spending Plan
  - Increased Training and Support
    - Provider Training Platform, Crisis Response Services, HIT, Resources for Parents with IDD and Caregivers of Children with IDD
  - Expanded Access
    - Behavioral Health, Aging and Disability Services Statewide System Evaluation
    - Pilot Projects
      - Therapeutic Foster Home
      - Community-Based Neurobehavioral Rehabilitation Services for Children
  - Workforce Support
    - Expand Direct Care Registry
    - Recruitment and Retention Provider Payments
