

Christ The King Council Meeting

July 23, 2024

Present: Father Nick Blaha, David Wright, Bob Brown, Bernardine Maher, Susan Reaves.

Guests: Teri Byers, George and Elizabeth Rebeck, Janet Dillman, Larry Wagner, Shannon Wright, Martin Cigich, John Christman.

Father Nick opened the meeting with a feast of St Bridget meditation.

Minutes were passed out and approved.

The changes in staff of the council were announced. Tony Ford resigned by communication with father, Fatima Dominguez and Patrick Cassidy resigned.

Taking their place will be Shannon Wright, Teri Byers, and Martin Cigich.

Father had some good news Adreanna Ford and Mary Wolf have decided to join the finance council so that will be getting underway. A financial is being worked on and will be presented to the parish when completed.

CTK has received grant money for the painting of Davern Hall, we need to decide on color schemes to get started. It was stated that we will probably have to paint over lower wall covering or find other solution because it can not be removed.

The renovation of the church pews was discussed and it was decided that we would look into different padding for the pews due to cost. Teri Byers said she would reach out to her contact at Carpet Corner and report back. We have 22,000 designated for the pews as of now.

We will discuss samples of material at the end of the meeting.

We have two new tenants at the school. Community Christian Academy has signed a 3 year lease and The Learning Club has signed a 5 year lease. They will be occupying the north side of the school building. The East side of the building will be saved for church use. Deep cleaning of the school has been completed and the tenants took over July 1st according to the lease date. Copies of the lease can be made available for anyone who is interested in it.

Catholic relics are in the kindergarten room for now.

Elizabeth Rebeck was concerned about the use of Davern Hall for lunches. Father replied that the church will always have the first option to use the hall, but for sanitary reasons he thought it would be best for them to eat in the hall whenever possible.

Following was discussion on placement of large items like copiers and things. It was said that Conception will continue to clean the school on a regular basis. Father said as of now he will be handling the maintenance of the school building. David Wright offered to be on the maintenance committee.

The question was asked how many parishioners we have at present. 792 individuals and 321 families.

Lastly it was reported that the closing of the school cost 275,000 dollars. The cost was covered by the archdiocese.

It was decided that father would make the agenda for the meetings until we get a permanent chairperson.

Next meeting will be August 27 at 6p.m.

The meeting concluded at 7:50 p.m.

The council then went up to the church to look at samples of pew coverings.
