

Christ The King Council Meeting

May 21, 2024

Meeting began at 6:05 pm

Those in attendance were: Father Nick, Lisa Gaume Fisher, Bob Brown, Bernardine Maher, Osmara Rodriguez, David Wright, and Susan Reaves.

Minutes from last month were revised by Lisa and handed out for approval.

Motion was made and the minutes were OKed and seconded and passed.

New Business began with discussion on a new Chairperson. Lisa is no longer able to fulfill the position as Chairperson so we will need to find a new Chairperson for council. No response to contact means you have vacated your position and are no longer interested. We will keep the positions open until the 31st of May and then Father Nick will contact Elizabeth Rebeck to get names of others who wanted to serve and reach out to them.

Next on the agenda father would like to do some sort of survey in the church, maybe bulletin asking about convenient times for masses during the week for our parishioners.

The Christ The King School Building may need a name change. One proposal is the CTK Community Building. The tenants that we are looking at at this time are the Learning Club and the Christian Academy.

The parish will have priority for Davern Hall, however the tenants would like to utilize it for their lunches while using the school when possible. Concerns were expressed about school upkeep costs, etc. Father said that at this time he expects a 1/3 split among all parties.

A question came up about being Virtus trained and Father Nick will look into it.

It is also expected that maintenance committee members will involve the renters of the building along with parishioners.

Concerning our finance committee, Mary Wolf showed interest in joining.

Discussion of renovations to the church followed. They included:

Paint in Davern Hall, Updating the cry room, Patch organ wall area, Covering of pews in church.

Father has two volunteers for painting, Rudy Padilla and Victor España, as soon as colors are chosen.

Father will also get samples for pew coverings as soon as possible.

Due to summer vacations our next meeting will not be till July 23 @ 6pm.
