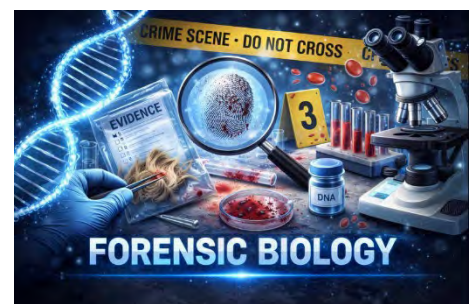

With a vision to expand its offerings, Forensic Academy Africa has submitted an application for accreditation of one additional qualification and believes the accreditation process will be concluded before 30 April 2026.

### 6.2. Assessment Centre

The QCTO in collaboration with its Quality Partners (QP), after receiving our application, conducted a site inspection of the institution's premises, and they accredit Forensic Academy Africa (07-QCTO-AC-TTC110724122242) to test and assess the Occupational Certificate: Fraud Examiner (SAQA 101868) at the accredited physical address (inclusive of online delivery) for a period of 5 years starting from 2024-07-11 to 2029-07-10, or until the expiry of the qualification or de-accreditation whichever comes first.
