

With a revamped focus, it aims to nurture professionals skilled in modern investigative techniques underpinned by ethical practices. The academy aims to blend theoretical knowledge with practical skills, extending its impact through industry partnerships and fostering a diverse student community. Emphasising digital infrastructure, it's set to revolutionise investigative forensic education in English-speaking African countries, aligning with its vision of leading with excellence, innovation, and social impact.

Accreditations




ORGANISATIONAL CHART
