Hello, August! Though it feels like we were just celebrating school being out for Summer and heading off on vacations, we are somehow back to packing backpacks and lunches, school traffic, and heading towards the joys of Fall. If you, like me, find yourself hoping for a time when things feel less busy, surely next month, right!?, the reality is, life's usually not that simple. It can feel as though it is an unending rollercoaster with joys and challenges throwing turns and loops every day.

There are times we get so into the throws life that nurturing our faith does not happen in the ways that we wish it would. We can feel guilty that what should be on the top of the list gets pushed further down. How is it that the things that can be the most life-giving are the first to put off? But in the midst of the twists and turns of life, our hearts crave a place to rest. A place to know we are loved, no matter what. Hand and Foot Card Group

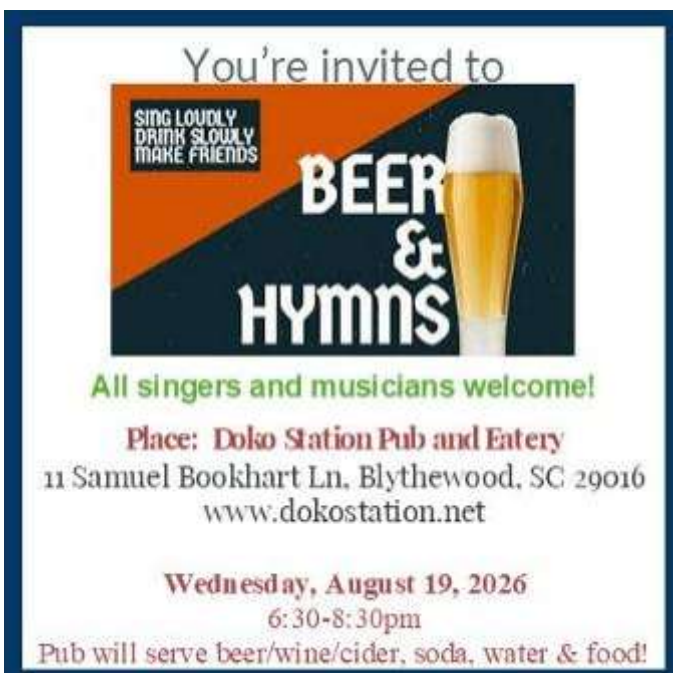
