## **Basketball:**

Basketball season will begin on Tuesday, November 18, 2025, with practices held every Tuesday and Thursday between 4:15 PM and 7:45 PM, depending on team placement. We will be offering both a skills team and multiple competitive teams.

- Skills Team: This team is ideal for athletes who are new to the sport or are still learning the basics. The focus will be on understanding the rules, learning positions, and building confidence through fundamental skill development.
- Traditional Teams: These teams are for athletes who have already developed basic skills
  of the sport and are ready for more structured gameplay and increased opportunities for
  competition.

\*\* Required by Special Olympics Ohio\*\*
There is a mandatory Basketball Skills Assessment.

This assessment will be held on Thursday, November 13th, 2025.

For last names that start with the letters A through M, the assessment will be held on at the BG Community Center between 5:00-6:15pm.

For last names that start with the letters N through Z, the assessment will be held on at the BG Community Center between 6:15-7:30pm

Assessments only take 15 minutes and will be done on a first come, first serve basis. Once your assessment is completed you may leave. Team rosters and the Winter Sports calendar will be sent out in your confirmation email once registrations are received and skills assessment scores are recorded.

#### **Swimming:**

Swimming season will begin on Monday, November 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025, with practices every Monday and Wednesday between 5:30-7:30pm depending on team placement. Athletes will be grouped by skill level and both groups will swim at BGSU's Cooper Pool.

# \*\*MINIMUM SWIM SKILLS REQUIRED FOR PARTICIPATION ON THE SWIM TEAM\*\*

- 1. Athletes must demonstrate breath control.
- 2. Athletes must be able to independently demonstrate a front glide with face in the water and both feet off the bottom of the pool for 2 pool lengths.

\*\* Required by Special Olympics Ohio
There is a mandatory Swimming Skills Assessment.

This assessment will be held on Wednesday, November 12th, 2025

For last names that start with the letters A through M, the assessment will be held at the Nichols Therapy Pool between 5:30-6:30pm.

For last names that start with the letters L through Z, the assessment will be held at the Nichols Therapy Pool between 6:30-7:30pm.

Assessments only take 15 minutes and will be done on a first come, first serve basis. Once your assessment is completed you may leave. If you are unable to make your time, please reach out to Coach Claire Griffith at <a href="mailto:cgriffith@woodcountydd.org">cgriffith@woodcountydd.org</a> ASAP to schedule your assessment.

Athletes participating in swimming will need to provide their own swimsuit, towel, and goggles.

Specific Team rosters and Winter Sports calendars will be sent in a confirmation email after registrations are received, and skill assessments are completed. Specific swim times will be included in the confirmation email.

\*All athletes <u>MUST</u> have a valid Special Olympics Ohio Registration, Release, Health History, & Medical form to be eligible to participate on file.

The minimum age to participate is 8.

Please be aware that the Special Olympics Ohio Release, Health History & Medical Forms HAVE been updated. If your Physical Exam form *is less than 3 years old* on the old forms, they are still valid.

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
