2. <u>Massillon City Schools request to shuttle from Rec Center to Tiger Stadium home</u> <u>games</u>

25-087 *Mr.* Colly moved; seconded by *Mr.* Schartiger to approve Massillon City Schools request to shuttle from Rec Center to Tiger Stadium home games. Motion carried 5-0 by roll call vote.

Steve Pedro: We've done this for them for a couple years. They've used the Rec Center parking lot on Friday nights, obviously. There are nine home games. We have them park in the corner over on that side. We close at 8:00 pm on Fridays. It hasn't been an issue.

Mr. Colly: Is there any cost?

Steve Pedro: No, no cost

3. Additional cameras at the Rec Center, not to exceed \$15,000

25-088 *Mr.* Colly moved; seconded by Ms. Spencer to approve additional cameras at the Rec Center, not to exceed \$15,000. Motion carried 5-0 by roll call vote.

Steve Pedro: After we sent this out, I received this from ProTech. We have a ProTech system in the building so we are kind of tied to ProTech too, if we want to add anything. We've had some issue in the back of the building, mostly. There are a couple of blind spots within the building since we've upgraded our system, five years ago. They sent this yesterday afternoon. Their total on here is \$14,380. Again, I received this after I sent the agenda out. I can send this everybody if you would like or if you would like to look at it. Whichever you would like. This is for about eight cameras that we are going to add to the building.

Mr. Hickey: In the back?

Steve Pedro: In the back and there are four inside the building that are blind spots where we've had some issues. Again, since we did this, we didn't realize, well we did. We duplicated the cameras from the previous install. We upgraded all of those. After the fact, we've had some issues in the hallway upstairs or back by the doors.

Mr. Hickey: How many cameras do you have total, down here?

Steve Pedro: 32 total. This will take us to about 40. With that being said, they have to add some storage in there as well. Right now, we have 45 days storage. Once they do this, it is going to go down to 28 days storage which I don't think is going to be an issue. In the future if we do need to add some more storage, we'll have that capability to get it back up. We had one incident where the police came and we were at 32 days another time it was 25 days. We were fortunate enough to get back up. I think we are going to be okay with 28 days.

Mr. Rivera: Most complaints are usually immediate

Steve Pedro: Yes

4. Sealcoat and stripe Wampler Park parking lot, not to exceed \$13,000

25-089 *Mr.* Schartiger moved; seconded by *Mr.* Colly to approve sealcoating and striping the Wampler Park parking lot, not to exceed \$13,000. Motion carried 5-0 by roll call vote.

Steve Pedro: I was hoping to get this done in the spring, with the weather, we just couldn't get anybody out here. We do have one quote as of now. I'm waiting on another quote and hope to have it by the end of the week. I put that number on here. The quote that we have is \$10,995. I'm waiting on one more quote to make that decision. I didn't wat to do it now because with the splash pad open, people would walk through the new coating and walk up into the splash pad. The engineers designed it for us and I will give that to whoever gets the job. The reason this is on the agenda now, is I want to get that approved now, if we could and get it scheduled for the middle of September. The splash pad will close the day after Labor Day. As soon as that is closed, I'm hoping to get this scheduled now, once I get that other quote.

Mr. Rivera: That makes sense

Mr. Colly: It's definitely needed
