



Patient Preventive Visit and Problem Visit Same Day Acknowledgement Form

- ✓ A Preventive Exam visit is a specific type of appointment to address preventive and screening care depending on age and gender. Examples include discussion of vaccines, mammograms, Pap smears, colonoscopies, birth control, and screening laboratory tests.
- ✓ A Problem-Oriented visit is different than a Preventive visit and includes the diagnosis, management, and treatment of new, ongoing, or active problems. Examples include, but are not limited to, colds, injuries, infections, diabetes, hypertension, pain, insomnia, depression, and medication management.
- ✓ If new or active chronic health problems are addressed during your Preventive visit, **you will be charged a co-pay for the problem-oriented part of your visit, as well as be subject to payments for your deductible, as applicable.**

We try to avoid this complication by scheduling preventive visits when your health problems are under control and/or have been recently addressed. However, sometimes problem-oriented discussions arise during preventive visits, and if time allows, we are happy to address them. In those cases, we can bill both the Preventive visit and the Problem-Oriented visit.
