

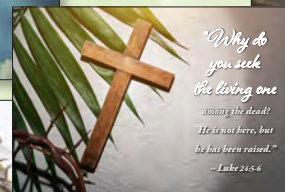
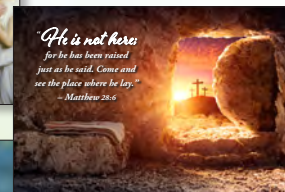

### Cathedral Letter Concepts will:

- Secure your parish's mailing list and Holy Triduum Schedule.
- Enhance your mailing list by checking all names and addresses against the National Change of Address (NCOA) registry.
- **CARD OPTION:** Print each Easter card on 80 lb. gloss cover stock, insert into A-7 mailing envelope printed one color with Church return address and personalize each mailing envelope. Seal and affix cards with a stamp.
- **POSTCARD OPTION:** Print each Easter postcard on 80 lb. gloss cover stock, personalize and print with indicia.
- Deliver card or postcard to the Post Office or ship to Parish for local mailing.

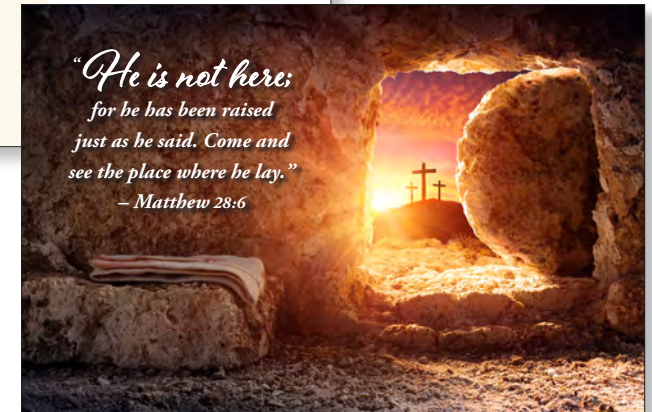

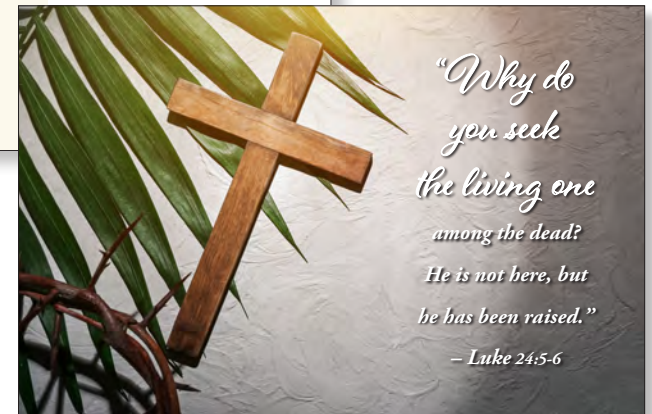
