



BLACK, PURPLE AND BLUE

Stars, alone and in the background of this picture, represent the Cross of Jesus Christ. We can't walk away from Him and His love for us. But that, for the devout Christian, is unthinkable. The responsible thing to do is to say, "Yes, dear Lord, I'll hold Calvary's Cross close to my heart and I will live for You!"

Back to our colors: Black, purple and blue. Black is the symbol of mystery. The mystery of grace and the mystery of God's love which brings good things out of things we do not understand! Purple stands for royalty. Truly, "The King of Love my Shepherd is". Blue is the symbol of hope, the sure confidence in the faithfulness of God, who brought joy and victory out of evil by raising Jesus Christ from the dead.

The initial INRI stands for the name of the Crucifix which was the Roman Cross, affixed to the top of the Cross. It means "Iesus Nazarenus Rex Iudeorum," "Jesus of Nazareth King of the Jews." Draped across the arms of the Cross is the long sheet, similar to the one probably used by those loving disciples who tenderly lowered His dead body from the cruel beam of torment.

Back to our colors: Black, purple and blue. Back to our coins of devotion. Now, at Easter we bring renewed dedication and a pledge of continuing loyalty. Your Church thanks you, appreciates the gifts and blesses the givers!


