Women of all ages and golfing levels are invited to come to Lakeside Goolwa May Week 2026 for fun, social activities and an enjoyable golfing experience.

**Thirty-Six-hole Championship - (2 days x 18 holes).** For golfers with a GA up to 36.6 (on day of entry).

**Eighteen-hole Championship (2 days x 9 holes).** For golfers with a GA 36.7 and above (on the day of entry) or others who prefer 9 holes each day.

**Social events** – Tuesday Welcome 9 holes and Friday Foursomes

#### ENTRY

Each player must enter the May Week Tournament events through MiTournament paying entry fees and other fees associated with social activities. Entries open at 7.00pm on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> February and close on Wednesday April 15<sup>th</sup> at 5pm or until fully booked. **The 36-hole championship field is restricted to 164 players and the 18-hole championship field to 80 players.** Refunds after entries close are at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.

Only players with an active Golf Australia Handicap or World Handicap may enter, ie a player with a Provisional handicap cannot enter. Entries for the 36 hole (ie 18 holes each day) are limited to players with a **maximum GA handicap of 36.6 on the day of**

**entry.** Entries for the 18 hole (ie 9 holes each day) are available to the full GA range and is especially designed for players with a GA 36.7 and above (on the day of entry). *Special price for players choosing 9 holes.*

A limited number of motorised carts are available for hire by contacting the Pro Shop (8555 2078). Buggies may be left in the Club during the Tournament for \$5 per night and push buggies can be hired.

Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> May 9-hole Stableford. Tee times between 12 noon and 3pm - *\$25 per player (Member \$15)*

Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> May at 5pm - Welcome function with a complimentary glass of wine. *\$25 per person.*

Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> May - Lakeside Goolwa May Week Championship Events

36-hole championship (ie 18 holes each day) *\$80 per player (Member \$30).*

18-hole championship (ie 9 holes each day) *\$60 per player (Member \$30).*

Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> - Presentation Dinner 6pm for 6.30pm. *\$60 per person includes welcome champagne*

Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May - 18-hole Foursomes (shotgun start at 8.30am) including presentation lunch *\$50 per player. (Member \$30).*

### 36 HOLE CHAMPIONSHIP OVER 2 DAYS (18 HOLES EACH DAY)

A & B Grade – 36-hole Stroke Championship – Gross

A & B Grade – 36-hole Stroke – Nett

C Grade – 36-hole Stableford Championship

#### Daily competitions

A & B Grade – 18-hole Stroke (Nett) on each day

C Grade – 18-hole Stableford on each day

**Maximum GA Handicap 36.6.** Play will be in handicap groups with a single tee start each day alternating early and later start (ie from 7.30am or approximately 9.00am)

No single day entries for the Championship will be accepted.

### 18 HOLE CHAMPIONSHIP OVER 2 DAYS (9 HOLES EACH DAY)

**Open to all GA handicaps (including players with a GA Handicap 36.7 and above).**

Graded (pending entries) 18-hole Stableford Championship – best aggregate 18-hole score over the two days

#### Daily competition

Graded 9-hole Stableford on each day (pending entries)

**No Maximum Daily Handicap.** Play will be in groups of 4 with a single tee start each day. Play will commence from about 11.00am – 1.00pm each day.

No single day entries for the Championship will be accepted.

## THE DRAW, STARTING TIMES AND SCORING

The draw for each event will be published at [www.southlakesgolf.com.au](http://www.southlakesgolf.com.au) from Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> April . It is the player's responsibility to be aware of their tee times.

**Each player must report to the Registration area under the Pro Shop veranda each day at least 20 minutes before their tee time.** Scoring will be through the MiScore App or with a card. Get the MiScore App from your app store for \$19.95/year with one free month which gives access to many other clubs throughout Australia.

## PRIZES

Daily Competitions:

- A & B Grade – 18-hole Stroke on each day – Nett (Winner & Runner-up and run down)
- C Grade – 18-hole Stableford on each day (Winner & Runner-up and run down)
- 9-hole Stableford each day, with prizes for Winner, Runner-Up, and run down; graded if enough entries.

Championship events:

- A & B Grade – 36-hole Stroke Championship – Gross (Winner & Runner-up)
- A & B Grade – 36-hole Stroke – Nett Championship (Winner & Runner-up)
- C Grade – 36-hole Stableford Championship (Winner, Runner-up, Third and Fourth)
- 18-hole Championship (Winner, Runner-Up, Third and Fourth) - graded if enough entries.

## LAKESIDE GOOLWA MAY WEEK 2026 – TERMS OF COMPETITION

1. The May Week 36-hole Championship events will be played in 3 grades A & B grade – Stroke/Nett; C grade – Stableford, on 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> May. Your handicap on the first day of championship play will determine your Grade and will be fixed for the two-day nett and Stableford events. **The maximum GA handicap is 36.6**
2. The May Week 18-hole Championship event is a Stableford event played on 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> May. Your handicap on the first day of championship play will be fixed for the two-day Stableford events. **For players with GA 36.7 and above** and open to the full range of GA handicap.
3. Other events include a 9-hole Stableford competition on 5<sup>th</sup> May and an 18-hole Foursomes competition on 8<sup>th</sup> May.
4. This Tournament is to be conducted under [Golf Australia "Codes of Conduct"](#).

The following are prohibited:

1. Consuming alcohol or a prohibited substance during the course of any round played in a competition.
2. Smoking cigarettes, cigars or vaping during the course of any round played in a competition.

In Addition: Mobile phones must be silenced/turned off during play. The penalty for breach of this condition is **two strokes**. A specific exemption has been granted by the Tournament Committee for use of mobile phones as a GPS, scoring eg. the MiScore App and the R&A Rules App. A mobile phone may be used for an on-course emergency.

5. The Tournament Committee will determine playing arrangements (including calling a suspension/cancellation of play where necessary) and will umpire in the case of a dispute or protest.
6. Play will be from the Red Tees and may alternate 1<sup>st</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Tee over both days.
7. The Tournament Pace of Play Policy is on display in the Clubhouse.
8. The use of a motorised cart is permitted.
9. For a player arriving at the starting tee, ready to play, within 5 minutes after the starting time, the penalty is **loss of 2 strokes at the first hole (Rule 5.3a)**. For Players arriving more than 5 minutes after the starting time the penalty for breach of this rule is **disqualification**.
10. Practice is not permitted on the Competition Course prior to a player's Tee time on the first championship day and between the playing of the two rounds of the Championship.
11. Players are expected to observe the dress standards and any other rules/requirements of the South Lakes Golf Club.
12. A dispute/protest must be lodged, in writing, with the Tournament Committee not later than 5 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play.
13. For the Championship events, first prize takes precedence over second prize and gross prize over nett prize. Prizes as listed above.
14. In the event of a tie for placings, a countback will apply, using the Australian Countback Method.
15. Championship prizes will be awarded at the Presentation Dinner.
16. The Tournament Committee has sole management and control of the event with full power at any time to alter or vary conditions. Any dispute shall be decided by the Tournament Committee and its decision will be final.
