Women of all ages and golfing levels are coming to Lakeside Goolwa May Week 2026 for fun, social activities and an enjoyable golfing experience.

ENTRY

Social events – Tuesday Welcome 9 holes, Welcome party, Thursday Presentation Dinner and Friday Foursomes

The 36-hole championship field is restricted to 180 players and the 18-hole championship field to 68 players. Refunds after entries close are at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.

Only players with an active Golf Australia Handicap or World Handicap may enter, ie a player with a Provisional handicap cannot enter. Entries for the 36 hole (ie 18 holes each day) are limited to players with a **maximum GA handicap of 36.6 on the day of entry**. Players with a higher handicap on the day of play will play to 36.6.

Entries for the 18 hole (ie 9 holes each day) are available to the full GA range and will play to full GA handicap.

MOTORISED CARTS AND BUGGY STORAGE

The use of motorised carts is permitted. 18 hole cart - \$50, 9 hole cart \$40. Players may be required to share a cart.

Buggies may be left in the Club during the Tournament for \$5 per night and push buggies can be hired \$5 per day.

EVENTS

Play will be in groups of 4 with a single tee start each day.

Tuesday 5th May 9-hole Stableford. Tee times between 12 noon and 3.30pm – off the 1st Tee. Results and Presentation of prizes at the Welcome function.

Tuesday 5th May at 5pm - Welcome function with a complimentary glass of wine, finger food and presentation of Tuesday welcome 9-hole competition. *Bookings required \$25.*

Wednesday 6th and Thursday 7th May - Lakeside Goolwa May Week Championship Events

36-hole championship (ie 18 holes each day). Wednesday off the 10th Tee 7.21am – 12.29pm (low to high handicap). Thursday off the 1st Tee 7.21am – 12.29pm (high to low handicap). Maximum daily handicap 36.6. Players with a higher handicap on the day of play will play to 36.6.

18-hole championship (ie 9 holes each day). Wednesday off the 10th Tee 12.45pm – 2.37pm. Thursday off the 1st Tee 12.45pm – 2.37pm. Players play to actual GA, ie up to GA 54.4

Thursday 7th - Presentation Dinner 6pm for 6.30pm. Fully booked

Friday 8th May - 18-hole Foursomes (shotgun start at 8.30am) including presentation lunch *\$50 per player. (Member \$30).*

CHAMPIONSHIP, RESULTS AND DAILY PRIZES

Daily Competitions:

- A & B Grade – 18-hole Stroke on each day – Nett (Winner & Runner-up and run down)
- C Grade – 18-hole Stableford on each day (Winner & Runner-up and run down)
- 9-hole Stableford each day, - Division 1 & 2 - prizes for Winner, Runner-Up and ungraded run down

Championship events:

- A & B Grade – 36-hole Stroke Championship – Gross (Winner & Runner-up)
- A & B Grade – 36-hole Stroke – Nett Championship (Winner & Runner-up)
- C Grade – 36-hole Stableford Championship (Winner, Runner-up, Third and Fourth)
- 18-hole Championship (Overall Winner, Runner-Up, Third and Fourth)

Daily results will be available from 6.30pm each day at www.southlakesgolf.com.au. Daily prizes can be collected from the Clubhouse.

Championship trophies and prizes will be presented at the Presentation Dinner on Thursday.

HOLE 3 – HOLE IN ONE AND NEAREST THE PIN PRIZES

- Nearest the Pin on Par 3s each day (prizes for 36- and 18-hole championship players).
- Hole in One Prize on the new Hole 3 – **first** hole in one over the Tournament, the Goolwa Air Scenic Flight for three prize.

THE DRAW, STARTING TIMES, SCORING AND RESULTS

The draw for each event are published at www.southlakesgolf.com.au . It is the player's responsibility to be aware of their tee times. The draws may be changed and the website will reflect the most up to date draws

Each player must report to the Registration area under the Pro Shop veranda each day at least 20 minutes before their tee time. Scoring will be through the MiScore App or with a card. Get the MiScore App from your app store for \$19.95/year with one free month which gives access to many other clubs throughout Australia.

Daily results available from 6.30pm each day at www.southlakesgolf.com.au. Prizes may be collected on Wednesday and Thursday in the Clubhouse. The Championship trophies and prizes will be presented at the Presentation Dinner on Thursday.

1. The May Week 36-hole Championship events will be played in 3 grades A & B grade – Stroke/Nett; C grade – Stableford, on 6th and 7th May. Your handicap on the first day of championship play will determine your Grade and will be fixed for the two-day nett and Stableford events. **The maximum GA handicap is 36.6 ie maximum Daily handicap 41.**
2. The May Week 18-hole Championship event is a Stableford event played on 6th and 7th May. Your handicap on the first day of championship play will be fixed for the two-day Stableford events. **No Maximum Daily Handicap, players play to full GA Handicap.**
3. Other events include a 9-hole Stableford competition on 5th May and an 18-hole Foursomes competition on 8th May.
4. This Tournament is to be conducted under the Rules and Golf and the Club's Local Rules (including any Temporary Local Rules). A copy of the Local and Temporary Local Rules will be available at the Registration Desk and the Clubhouse.
5. This Tournament is to be conducted under [Golf Australia "Codes of Conduct"](#).
The following are prohibited:
 1. Consuming alcohol or a prohibited substance during the course of any round played in a competition.
 2. Smoking cigarettes, cigars or vaping during the course of any round played in a competition.
6. Mobile phones must be silenced/turned off during play. The penalty for breach of this condition is **two strokes**. A specific exemption has been granted by the Tournament Committee for use of mobile phones as a GPS, scoring eg. the MiScore App and the R&A Rules App. A mobile phone may be used for an on-course emergency.
7. The Tournament Committee will determine playing arrangements (including calling a suspension/cancellation of play where necessary) and will umpire in the case of a dispute or protest.
8. Play will be from the Red Tees, Day 1 off the 10th Tee and Day 2 off the 1st Tee for each championship event.
9. The Tournament Pace of Play Policy is on display in the Clubhouse. Players must play Ready Golf according to the Rules of Golf and are expected to peel off from the hole to the next Tee once two players have completed the hole. Course Marshalls will be on course to assist with maintaining the field. Spotters will assist with searching for balls, raking bunkers and calling up players on Par3s as necessary. On-course volunteers will not give rules advice or adjudicate dispute between players. In such case the Rules Official should be called.
10. The use of a motorised cart is permitted. Players may be requested to share a cart.
11. For a player arriving at the starting tee, ready to play, within 5 minutes after the starting time, the penalty is **loss of 2 strokes at the first hole (Rule 5.3a)**. For Players arriving more than 5 minutes after the starting time the penalty for breach of this rule is **disqualification**.
12. Practice is not permitted on the Competition Course prior to a player's Tee time on the first championship day and between the playing of the two rounds of the Championship.
13. Players are expected to observe the dress standards and any other rules/requirements of the South Lakes Golf Club.
14. A dispute/protest must be lodged, in writing, with the Tournament Committee not later than 5 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play.
15. For the Championship events, first prize takes precedence over second prize and gross prize over nett prize. Prizes as listed above.
16. In the event of a tie for placings, a countback will apply, using the Australian Countback Method.
17. Championship prizes will be awarded at the Presentation Dinner.
18. The Tournament Committee has sole management and control of the event with full power at any time to alter or vary conditions. Any dispute shall be decided by the Tournament Committee and its decision will be final.
