 - Monitoring and recording data in site log books
- Clean and disinfection of hot and cold water systems
- Clean and disinfection of cold water storage tanks
- Sampling of domestic hot and cold water systems
- Closed system flushing and chemical treatment
- Working in confined spaces and working at heights
- Other ad-hoc duties, as required
