Freedom in Christ

"It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery" (Galatians 5:1).

On July 4th we give thanks for the freedom that we enjoy in our nation and for those who have made sacrifices to help bring us that freedom.

But the freedom that we enjoy as Christians is even more important. Jesus died on the cross and rose again from the dead so that we would be free to live as His people.

This is a freedom that must be safe-guarded. In Galatians 5 (above), the apostle Paul cautions his readers not to "be burdened again by a yoke of slavery." He was referring to the fact that there were some among them, known as the Judaizers, who insisted that if they really wanted to be Christians that they must follow all of the laws under the Old Covenant, specifically circumcision.

Now, there's nothing wrong with following God's Law. It is good in every way. The problem was, that they believed that by doing so, they would be saved. And as Paul wrote, "no one will be justified by the keeping of the Law" (Romans 3:20). The Law was never intended to the be the way by which a person gained eternal life. Instead, it was to show us us our sin and therefore point us to the One who alone can forgive us our sin and give us eternal life, and that is Jesus Christ. By faith in Him, we are forgiven and free! And Paul is saying that Jesus has set you free. So why would

you ever want to go back to a way of life that would only enslave you all over again?

Now this, of course, doesn't mean that we are free to do whatever we please, no matter what. The Lord has given us freedom within limits. When God placed Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden, they were at liberty to do anything they wanted, except for one thing: They were not to eat of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. It was a freedom within certain boundaries.

And God gives us liberty within certain boundaries. Absolute, unbridled freedom with no limits whatsoever, would lead to chaos. So, God, in His love for us, sets up borders, beyond which we are not to go. We have freedom within limits.

Freedom for what purpose? To enjoy life? Yes. But especially freedom to serve others.

We are saved by God's grace through faith in Jesus Christ, not by keeping the Law. But we are saved for the purpose of fulfilling God's Law, meaning that we are free to love Him and others. Now that Jesus has set us free, let's use that freedom to serve!
