"Lost Sheep"

"the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost" Luke 19:10

I recently read the story about Shrek, the sheep that had evaded capture and shearing for 6 years. When he was finally discovered in a high mountain cave in New Zealand, he was almost unrecognizable as a sheep.

The first thing his rescuer did was pin back his wool so he could see to walk.

News about about Shrek's return soon spread and reporters from all over came to get a closer look. To top it all off, on live television, world champion shearer Peter Casserly came and sheared off the six years of wool. All together it was a foot thick!

Shrek's story is not unlike ours. Isaiah the prophet declares that "we all like sheep have gone astray. Everyone has turned to his own way"

(Isaiah 53:6). We were cut off from God because of our sin. We were doomed to spend eternity in hell. If we were going to make it back to Him, someone would have to come looking for us. And that someone was Jesus. Through His suffering and death and His glorious resurrection, He brought us back to our God.

And having found us, He cleaned us up and gave us the gift of life that will never end, a gift that brings us great joy.

But it's a joy that He wants to experience with everyone. You see, the work of seeking and saving the lost is something that continues to this day. Jesus, the Good Shepherd is still looking for lost sheep. And the way that He does that is through His church, which is right in line with our mission as a congregation. That we exist to know Christ and to make Him known.
