Uninsured Does Not Mean Unemployed



When we speak in the community about the work of Mustard Seed, many assume the majority of our patients are unemployed. Many of our patients are employed at jobs that do not provide health care benefits. Patients who are newly unemployed come to Mustard Seed after losing their health insurance and their job.

Some patients may be self-employed, or small business owners, part-time workers or single parents. These uninsured individuals contribute to the wealth of our community but are unable to afford health insurance for themselves and their family due to the high cost. These may be the people you see and interact with everyday... the waitress at your coffee shop, the clerk at your local store, the housekeeper that cleans your home, the teacher's aide at your children's school or the handyman who makes repairs.... these are only a few faces of the uninsured and the patients who receive care at Mustard Seed Community Health.
