- 1. Read over the questions together and discuss your answers from the YouCat & Bible section.
- 2. Tell your sponsor how your daily prayer commitment has been going so far. Discuss if it has gotten easier to pray each day. Do you pray longer now than you did a few months ago, if not, try to add a few minutes to your daily prayer.
- 3. Sponsor: What do you remember about your confirmation? What name did you choose? Why did you pick this name? Share it with your candidate.
- 4. Discuss virtue, specifically the virtue of humility. Explain to your sponsor how you recently practiced humility.
- 5. Discuss the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. Candidates, tell your sponsor which works you are turning in with this packet. Sponsor: Which Work of Mercy do you find most challenging to practice?
- 6. What has been most challenging and most fruitful in your preparation so far?
- 7. End your discussion by praying the *Litany of Humility* together.
