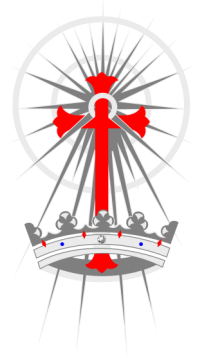

5. Discuss the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. Candidates, tell your sponsor which works you are turning in with this packet and explain how you grew from them.
6. End your discussion by praying the *Divine Mercy Chaplet* for our parish priests. The chaplet may be found in the red pamphlet given at the January brunch.
