

Dear Residents,

Most of you have heard by now TPC is hosting the American Family Champions Professional Golf Tournament in Cherokee between June 2nd and June 8th . This will represent a traffic challenge for owners entering our development. For security reasons, Madison Police will have two checkpoints. One at the intersection of Comanche and Wheeler Road, and one on Sherman Avenue on the north side of the intersection of Sherman Ave. and Wheeler Road. No vehicles will be allowed without proper identification through the checkpoints. They will however allow delivery vehicles, caretakers, emergency vehicles and homeowners through. The American Family tournament will be mailing or delivering two passes per unit to get through the checkpoints. Driveways along Wheeler Road will not have a checkpoint. Watch your mail for your resident passes! We will keep you posted for more information. These passes are only to get through the checkpoints and to identify your cars.

To avoid unauthorized parking by non-residents in our private roadway system, we will be requiring vehicles parked in the outdoor parking lots, driveways and roadways during the tournament will need to have their resident pass displayed on the dash of their vehicles to avoid being towed. Am Fam will also provide us some signage.

This tournament will have over 5,000 people attending and the economic impact for the area is in the millions of dollars. The tournament has raised over 19 million dollars from proceeds from the event so the money raised for this event goes to many good causes. There will be hundreds of volunteers working at this event so hopefully the weather holds up and the event is a big success. The Association will change staff schedules to ensure we have a constant presence on our grounds during the week and on the weekend. The busy days will be June 6, 7 and 8. If everyone exercises a little patience during the event we should have few problems.

Spring is here! The pools have been cleaned out and we are preparing the fountain systems and grounds for summer. The staff really appreciated the mild winter and we were able to get good start on equipment maintenance, mulch, and spring clean up, so 2025 is off to a great start.
