Dear Residents,

December started off with some tough Wisconsin winter weather. Winter presents challenges to the staff dealing with snow, freezing rain, ice, cold temperatures and strains on the building systems. The roofs so far have held up very well with no reports of leakage. When we replace roofs we really put an emphasis on waterproofing the roof deck with top quality underlayment in critical places under the shingles. These details make a big difference in the type of weather conditions we are facing this winter.

The cold has also caused a couple of frozen pipes this year. In one case a zone valve failed and the heating pipe between first and second floor froze and split near the outer wall of the unit. Reminder, if your heat ever goes out in very cold weather, call us right away to get your unit heating again before any pipes freeze.

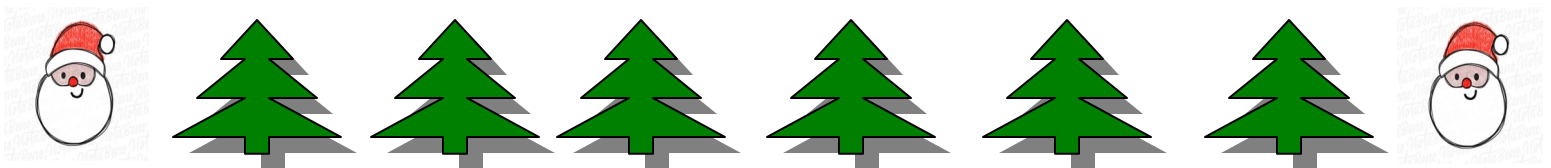
In one building we had an electrical short in a bath fan that caused a smoldering type fire. Fortunately the owner of the unit noticed some smoke and did everything right. The owner pulled the fire alarm pull station in the hallway and contacted 9-1-1. The fire department arrived while it was still smoldering and quickly put it out without a fire hose. We checked other fans in the building and didn't find anything wrong except some were covered in quite a bit of dust. If you notice one of your fans, or any appliance for that matter, are making a noise or sounding different, turn it off and call maintenance or an appliance expert for advice. Some of these appliances are getting old, so we suggest upgrading appliances if possible before they fail because none of us know exactly *how* they will fail.

With Christmas approaching and many people buying presents online, an enormous amount of boxes and packaging materials will need proper disposal. The big culprits are boxes. We have to put boxes in the trucks completely flattened. Boxes need to be cut and bundled tightly. Also, styrofoam is not recycled by the City; put it in a regular trash bag. We have a very unique trash collection process and it helps tremendously if you take the time to break everything down properly especially on the biggest trash days of the year.
