Dear Residents,

Mid July is where plants finally start to slow down and staff can catch up on pruning the prolific growth. Warm weather and rain accelerate the plant growth making it difficult to keep up and this summer again had perfect growing conditions. The crew is really working hard to get the landscape plantings under control.

Many of the trees in the development have been stressed with high heat and rain causing numerous different fungus issues and blights. Crabapples, spruce trees and a few more ash trees have taken a hit with weather related issues and borers. We treat the ash trees but it is not 100% effective. This leads to more tree removals. Once the hot weather subsides the replacement tree planting will resume.

The new system where we have to transport all of our landscape materials to the City of Madison drop off point is really an eye opening experience for the staff due to the sheer volume of plant debris we produce daily. The crew really create a tremendous amount of brush and yard waste which must be dropped off separately *every* day. Our new dump trailer is really helping us speed up the transportation process but it is still a really big job compared to dropping it off curbside.

Golf Parkway will be paved later this summer likely in mid to late August. The new pavement will be better than new once completed. The plan is to replace all the driveways and parking lots on Golf Parkway first. This will take a few weeks due to the amount of work needed to prepare the gravel road base for pavement. All the work by the entrances of the garages is hand work and to do it right takes a little extra time. The main section of roadway itself will be replaced last. The new roadway will be a welcome improvement.
