## MUNN'S LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

We acknowledge with gratitude that Munn's United Church is on the traditional territory of the Anishinabek, Haudenosaunee, the Huron-Wendat, and most recently the Mississauga's of the Credit, Indigenous Peoples.

This territory was first covered under the 1795 Upper Canada Treaty 3 and 3/4 known as the Brant Tract which included agreement to peaceably share and care for the lands around the Great Lakes. The sum of purchase was 100 (British) pounds. In 1805 the land was transferred under Treaty 13A Head of the Lake Purchase for 2000 (British) pounds.

Today, many Indigenous people call this home, including survivors and intergenerational family members who have been impacted by the legacy of the residential school system. We honour them as we stand, committed to being partners in healing, truth telling, reconciliation, and justice.
