This position serves prepared lunches to our Kindergarten - 8th grade students over 3 lunch periods, and washes dishes following lunch times **Monday - Friday on school days from 10:30 am - 1:30 pm** for the 2025-26 school year.

The Position:

Catered hot lunches are pre-ordered from a caterer and delivered each morning. The lunch server follows food safety protocols in temping the food and keeping it at a safe temperature until serving. They then plate and serve the lunches for each of the 3 lunches, following serving size guidelines, and use a commercial dishwasher/sanitizer to wash the trays, silverware and serving dishes and utensils.

Qualifications:

- Current Food Service certification, or ability to get certified within 30 days of hire
- Committed to the mission of Christian Education and Spiritual Development of children
- Experience handling and serving food
- Positive attitude, professional appearance and demeanor
- Good oral and written communication skills
- Able to lift up to 50 lbs occasionally, bend, twist, walk and stand for extended periods of time
- Ability to pass a background check
