Introduction

Come, walk with me. This is an invitation to come along as we learn to follow Jesus together. Although this is a written guide, it should be used as a tool to build a relationship with Jesus and each other. Jesus said to us, "Come, follow Me," not "Come, study Me." My desire is that we would practice following the way of Jesus and be changed by Him in the process.

The following material is meant to be studied and discussed in the context of community, either one-on-one or a small group setting. The topics and Scriptures highlighted will be a good starting point to launch us on this journey with Jesus.

It will work well when we commit to read through the daily Scripture references and then come together for one hour each week to discuss the main observations and any questions that arise. It is also important to verbalize and write down the action steps that each of us will take from our reading, reflection, and discussion. Without taking action steps, all of our reading and discussion will just be "food for thought." Remember – following Jesus is practicing a new way of life not simply studying a book.

After discussing what God has been saying to us, we will take some time to pray for each other. Feel free to share any specific burdens for prayer or any highlights for thanksgiving. It is important, as well, to pray each time before opening the Bible. The Holy Spirit will be speaking personally to us as we read. So, it is good to acknowledge Him and ask for His wisdom and insight, as we spend time with Him in the Bible.

Let's walk together and learn to follow Jesus one step and a time.

Conclusion

This season of walking together is meant to be a launching point for an ongoing walk of following Jesus. Discipleship is not an event (i.e. "been there, done that"), but a continual process of following the Master one step at a time. Our growth from this point is contingent on walking with others and pointing them toward a life with Jesus.

You were never meant to be the last link in the chain. Jesus' desire is that we would be disciples who make disciples. On that basis, who is someone that you could invite into a relationship of walking together - meeting weekly, discussing God's Word, making action plans, and praying together? Take some time to consider and pray about inviting another person to walk with you just like we have done for the last six months.

If we focused on walking with one other person for the next six months, and then those people walked with others after that, do you realize the exponential growth of people following Jesus that would happen? It just takes each one of us to do our part - faithfully following Jesus and bringing others along with us.

Just as you have walked with me, walk with someone else. Let's invite more people onto the path of following Jesus.
