1. Navigating Home Education in British Columbia

This workshop is designed for parents, churches, and educators to clarify the distinct paths available for home education options in B.C., helping families bridge the gap between their faith and their child's education. We will explore the primary options for educating your child at home, including their responsibilities, benefits, and how they fit within the provincial education system.

Steve Bastian's journey in education began as a home-educated student himself from grades 7-12, an experience that shaped his vision for learning and family discipleship. For the past 13 years, he and his wife have been home-educating their own children, walking alongside them in both academics and faith. Trained as a teacher and now serving as an administrator within the home education system, Steve combines professional expertise with personal experience to support families in their home education journeys. He is passionate about helping parents see that God has a unique plan for each child and believes education is a powerful tool for guiding children toward their calling and purpose.

2. Navigating Through Current Ideologies and Trends in the B.C. Curriculum Presented by Berenice MacKenzie

This seminar will help parents and educators recognize and interpret the core and curricular competencies in the B.C. curriculum so that they feel more aware and empowered when preparing lessons and choosing resources that align with a Christian worldview.
