Student Impact in Reading

Thanks to the Heartland Education Foundation and Accelerate grant, we have helped 283 struggling readers at Heartland schools to close their reading gaps during School Year 2023-2024.

Over 150 certified, high-quality Air Reading teachers taught more than 6,000 hours to students in small groups, focused on their individual needs, virtually during school.

Students have improved an average 27%-44% in Oral Reading Fluency, 2-4X higher the reading growth on national reading assessment NWEA MAP, and an average 12-point percentile increase on STAAR.


Student Growth

Based on Johns Hopkins University's Research, Air Reading has increased 45% of student growth at Dietz.



Based on Johns Hopkins University's Research, Air Reading has increased 44% of student growth at Walker.



"They really engaged. Students are looking forward to it."


"I love how Air Reading teachers are building relationships with the kids."
