These prices are effective as of October 9, 2023

Payment for goods and services is expected prior to the services rendered, unless other arrangements have been made prior to need. For your convenience, we accept cash, check, credit card (Visa, MasterCard or American Express), a verifiable irrevocable insurance assignment, or financing through a financial institution.

The goods and services shown on the General Price List are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

We are dedicated to providing the best services at the most reasonable cost. The cost of a funeral is comprised of many individual charges and is determined by the choices a family makes.

Our services are divided into six main categories:

- Professional Services
- Other Care of Deceased
- Use of Facilities
- Automotive Equipment
- Merchandise
- Other Supplemental Services

We offer package prices which cost less than itemized goods and services when individually selected. No matter what your funeral preference, your funeral director can help you with every aspect of the funeral process. If you want to design your own type of service, you may start with Professional Services (our Basic Services fee is mandatory, but everything else is your choice), then add what you would like from Other Care of Deceased, Facilities, Equipment, Other Supplemental Services. Please ask your funeral director if there is something else you would like to see. We'll do our very best to accommodate you.

Basic professional services of funeral director and Staff\$2,195

This is the basic charge to each family which we serve for our professional expertise in assisting them. It includes, but is not limited to, a proportionate share of other taxes, licenses, utilities and business expenses necessary to serve the public in a professional manner. Included in this charge is the consultation with the family, clerical and administrative services, preparation and filing of necessary permits, consultation with the clergy, cemetery, crematory or common carrier, planning the funeral, and placement of obituary notices. There will be an additional charge for the direction and supervision of each service requested or required. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains).

\$500 Embalming.....

Embalming is a chemical process which provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. A person licensed by this state must complete this procedure. Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with extended viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Modified preparation..... \$295

This service is for families who choose not to have embalming, but want to have a viewing. This charge includes sanitary care of human remains and setting of features. A person licensed by the state must complete this procedure.

Other care of the deceased Identification viewing......\$395

This service provides families an opportunity to have a brief viewing of unembalmed human remains for identification or religious purposes up to but not to exceed 24 hours. This service includes modified preparation of the human remains and the placement in a casket/cremation container.

These caskets are not designed by the manufacturer to resist the entrance of air, water or other outside elements. They may be constructed of metal, hardwood or wood products covered with fabric. A complete list of the caskets offered will be provided in this general price list.

Expedited Services or witness cremation......\$295

Scheduled Burials and cremations that are scheduled up to four days after death has occurred will require additional communications with the Doctor's and/or Coroner's office. (Doctors and the Coroners have up to three working days to finalize their portion of a Death Certificate which also includes the burial/transit permit needed for burial or cremation.). The witness cremation requires extra time and scheduling at the crematory.

Alkaline Hydrolysis (Aqua Cremation)...... \$2,095

A process that is an eco-friendly alternative to flame cremation. It uses water instead of fire to return a body back to Mother Nature through Alkaline Hydrolysis. This service includes: the basic services of the funeral director and administrative staff for obtaining and filing legal documents; removal of the deceased from the place of death to the mortuary within a 25 miles radius; sanitary care of the remains; refrigeration equipment for holding remains up to 3 days; transportation of the deceased for the Aqua Cremation and a temporary urn. This service does not include other preparation of remains, viewing or use of the facilities for viewing, funeral service or cash advance items. THIS SERVICE DOES NOT REQUIRE A CREMATION CONTAINER

Natural Organic Reduction\$6095

Terramation utilizes the body's own naturally occurring microbes to gently transform remains into nutrient rich soil. The process is conducted in individual vessels and takes about 60 days. The resulting soil can then be returned home to be used by the family to create a meaningful tribute. *Price includes basic services of funeral director and staff; transfer of remains to funeral home; refrigeration (up to 5 days); transfer of remains to the facility; and the terramation fee.

Forwarding of remains to another funeral home Ship-out/no local service......\$2,095

Ship-in/graveside service (casketed remains).....\$2,395

Other municipal airports charge for mileage is \$3.00 per loaded mile. This service does not include: a limousine, other preparation of the remains, dressing, casketing, cosmetizing, casket, outer burial container, cemetery charges, memorial register, memorial folders or acknowledgement cards and other cash advance items.

Ship-in/delivery to local cemetery.....\$1,795

This includes professional services of staff in the coordination and supervision of all details in the care, planning and arrangement of final disposition, accommodating persons telephoning or visiting the funeral home, providing basic facilities and equipment; automotive equipment including to Portland Airport and casket coach to cemetery. Other municipal airports charge for mileage is \$3.00 per loaded mile. This service does not include: a limousine, embalming, other preparation of the remains, dressing casketing, costmetizing, casket outer burial container, cemetery charges, memorial register, memorial folders or acknowledgement cards and other cash advance items, or visitation or funeral ceremony.

Immediate burial/entombment (no family present)......\$2,095

This service includes: the basic services of funeral director and staff, administrative staff for obtaining and filing legal documents; removal of the deceased from the place of death to the mortuary within a 25 mile radius; sanitary care of the remains; modified preparation; refrigeration equipment for holding remains for up to three days; transportation of the deceased to the cemetery for burial. This service does not include; embalming, viewing use of facilities; funeral or graveside service; casket outer burial container, burial charges, or other cash advance items.
