2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR

Research shows that uniforms and dress codes reduce peer pressure, promote unity and safety, and support a focused learning environment. In collaboration with staff and families, we've updated our dress code to create a more unified appearance across the school.

- Dress code applies to all students in Grades K–8.
- Preschool students are not required to follow the dress code, but should wear school-appropriate clothing.
- Approved colors and options are listed below.
- Angel's Attic is available for all families - gently-used dress code items are \$1.00.
- Families may also order items through French Toast: www.frenchtoast.com ("Navy Red Plaid" is the chosen pattern) or globalschoolwear.com/school/STRO07 (School code: STRO07)
- **Special Note for 8th Grade:**
Powers Catholic dress code bottoms may be worn **starting 2nd semester only**. No other Powers uniform items are allowed. Powers skirts and shorts must be **knee-length or longer**.

Dress Code Violations (Grades K–8)

- 1st offense: verbal reminder; student may be given clothing from Angel's Attic if needed
- 2nd offense: parent notified via email by homeroom teacher
- 3rd offense: phone call from the office; **Friday Jean Day privilege suspended**

Item	Colors	Acceptable Options
 Shirts, Blouses, Polos	Solid red, white, or navy	• Brand logos or emblems are discouraged but must be smaller than a quarter • Styles: Long or short sleeve plain collared shirts. Shirts must be tucked in.
 Pants, Slacks, or Shorts	Solid navy or khaki	• Traditional full length dress pants; Elastic or traditional waist with traditional hip pockets. No tight fitting pants. • Jogger-style dress pants are allowed • Walking shorts or capri pants acceptable April 1 – Nov 1. (must be knee length).
 Jumpers, Skirts, or Skorts	Solid navy, khaki, or plaid	• Must be knee length • Compression shorts should be worn under jumpers/skirts that do not have built in shorts. • Leggings in solid black, khaki and navy may be worn under skirt/skorts or jumpers. Leggings must be free of tears or holes. Leggings or tights must be worn Nov. 1-March 31 under skirt/skorts or jumpers.
 Sweaters/Vests	Solid navy, red, white	• Four Styles: (cardigan, v-neck, crew or vest) • Collared shirt worn beneath • No hooded sweaters
Socks	Solid white, navy, khaki, red, or black	• All students must wear socks. No show footies, anklets, tights, knee highs, and mid-calf socks are approved. ○ Footies and anklets may vary in color. ○ Knee/calf socks must be solid dress code colors only.

Other	NOT Acceptable	Acceptable Options
Shoes & Boots	● Sandals, open toed, open- backed, wheels (heelys), heels greater than 1 inch may not be worn. Crocs are not acceptable. ● Winter boots may not be worn in the classroom	● Dress flat or athletic shoes with backs and toes. ● Heels of <i>less than 1 inch</i>. ● Ankle height boots are acceptable (height comparable to high-top tennis shoes).
Makeup/Jewelry	● Face glitter, tattoos, and face/nose/tongue piercings are NOT allowed. ● Sweatbands, hoop earrings, dangling earrings, body piercings, or large necklaces/bracelets are NOT acceptable.	● It is highly recommended that makeup not be worn; Jewelry is to be kept to a minimum. ● Small neck chains or single bracelets that are subtle are acceptable. ● Earrings for girls should be single stud or less than ½ inch.
Hair	● Hair extensions, hair feather extensions, tinsel, animal ear headbands, and facial hair are NOT acceptable.	● For both male & female; hair must be clean and neat. No extreme hair colors or styles.

Dress Code vs. Spirit Wear

Spirit wear orders will be placed throughout the school year in September, November, and early spring. Spirit wear sweatshirts and attire may be worn on jeans days & casual days. Please note that the SRS Spirit Store carries a variety of SRS attire. Spirit wear with the SRS shield only may be worn as a part of the regular dress code. **We have a new shield this year, which may also be worn. NOTE: We will not be retiring the shield from the past!**

Shield = may be worn daily as part of the dress code



Block letters = Spirit Wear



Sweatshirts (purchased from SRS Spirit Store)	Solid white, navy or red	• Quarter Zip & Crewneck - may be worn daily. (No hooded sweatshirts on regular dress days). • Comes with SRS shield.
Polo Shirts (purchased from SRS Spirit Store)	Solid white, navy or red	• Short-sleeve and long sleeve. May be worn daily. • Comes with SRS shield.
Spirit Wear Sweatshirts, T-shirts (purchased from SRS Spirit Store)	Solid Navy or Red	• Hooded sweatshirt; crewneck sweatshirt. • Long and short sleeved t-shirt • Comes with "St. Robert Catholic" in Red & White block letters across the chest. • May only be worn on Casual Days or Jean Days

Jean Days (each Friday) *Jean Days are a privilege!*

- Blue denim jeans / jean shorts may be worn
 - No tears or holes
- SRS spirit wear shirt or a dress code shirt may be worn.

Sports Team Game Days

- Sports team jerseys are to be worn by the entire team on the day of a game or the Friday preceding the game.
- A dress code shirt must be worn under the jersey (*A collar is mandatory*).
- Dress code pants are to be worn (unless otherwise announced).

Casual Days *Casual Days are a privilege!*

- Jeans (follow normal Jean Day rules)
- Sweatpants/Athletic pants or knee length shorts (must be clean and in good condition)
 - No leggings, yoga pants, or tight-fitting pants
 - No pajamas or sleepwear
 - Shorts must be knee length
- T-shirts, sweatshirts, and hoodies
 - Logos must be school-appropriate (no references to alcohol, drugs, or politics)
 - No tank tops, sleeveless, tight, or revealing/midriff shirts
