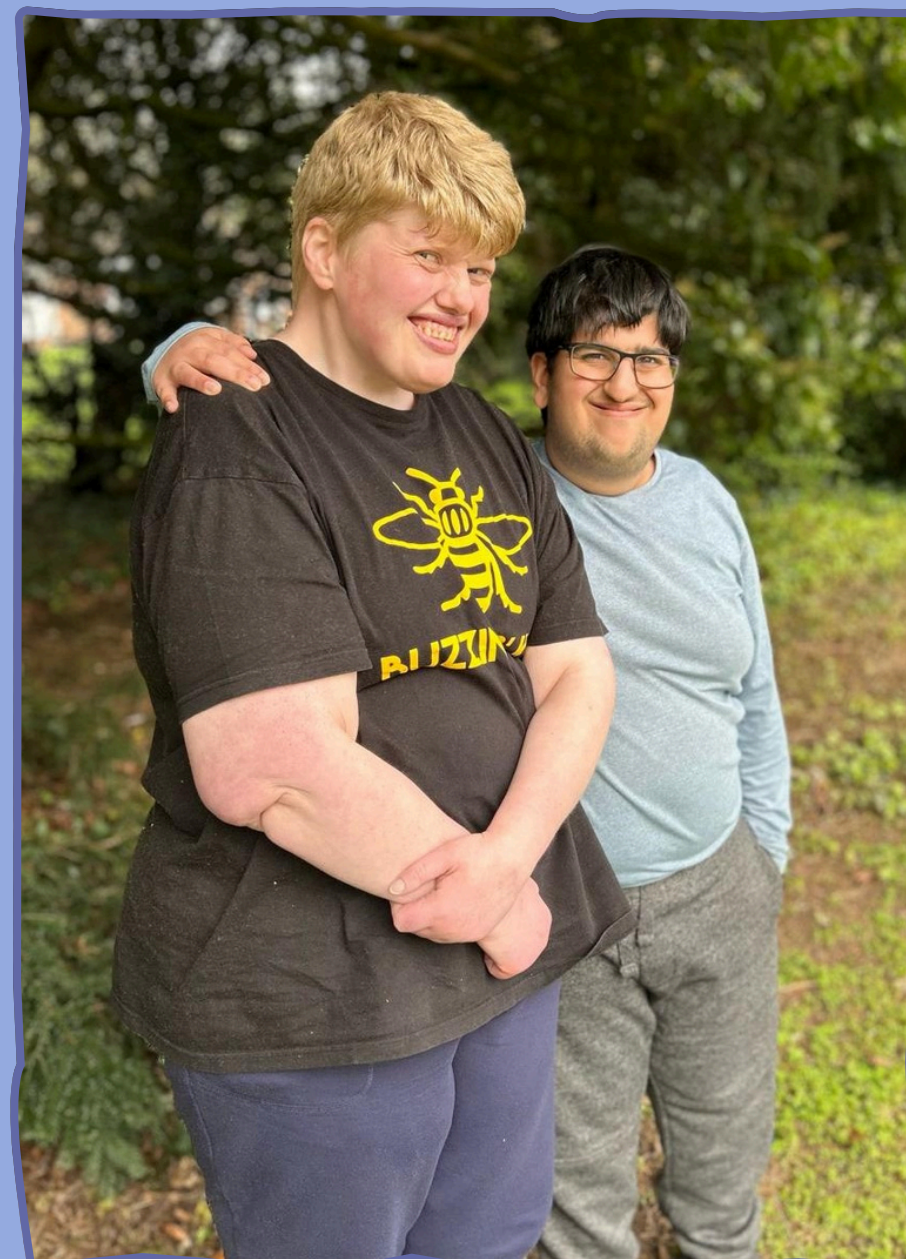

The condition is complex, requiring specialist medical care, structured support, and urgent advancements in treatment options.
