- Wearing clothing that leaves knees or shoulders exposed is prohibited.
- Speaking loudly or playing music in sacred spaces is prohibited.

Photography and Video Rules:

- Always obtain permission before photographing or filming religious leaders, children, or strangers.
- Unauthorized photography is strictly prohibited.

Monuments and Historical Artifacts:

- Do not sit or lean on carvings or fragile surfaces.
- Do not touch, move, or transport archaeological artifacts. Selling these items is also prohibited.

Alcohol and Smoking Rules:

- Consumption of alcohol or smoking is prohibited in restricted areas.

Rules Regarding Children:

- Instead of giving money or sweets to children, donate to recognized charities if you wish to help.

Community Conduct:

- Publicly exposing genitalia is prohibited and punishable by law.

Wildlife and Environmental Protection:

- Avoid buying illegal products made from endangered wildlife species.
- Littering or polluting the environment is strictly forbidden and punishable if detected.
