Hole One

PAR 5 HCP 9/5

Straight away Par 5, reachable in two shots if you are successful in avoiding the fairway bunker on the right side of fairway. Approach shot into green requires precise thought. The green is severely sloped from back to front. Try to stay below the hole.



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
Hole Two

PAR 5 1/13

This double dogleg is all about strategy. A well-struck tee shot favoring the left side will allow for an easy second shot lay up. The blind approach to the green will require exact yardage in order to avoid the well-placed bunker on left front of green. Favor the left side for second shot. The putting surface is relatively flat. Favor the left side of green for ease in putting. Don't be long over the green...trouble awaits.



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Hole Three

PAR 4 1/1CP 1/1

This slight dogleg left is deceptively difficult. Favor the left side off the tee as the fairway slopes from left to right. The multi-tiered putting surface slopes from back to front. Try to stay below the hole. Trouble is lurking for those that miss the green long and left.







Hole Four

PAR 3 14CP 17/17

This hole requires a solidly struck mid to long iron. The open ended front portion of the green allows for a skillful run up shot. Be careful to avoid the bunkers on the left and right side of the putting surface. Yet another green that slopes severely from back to front. A smart play would be to play for the front part of the green and walk away with two putts or a short chip and a putt.

Hole Five

PAR 4 HCP 5/9

This hole is all about pure length off the tee. An elevated, hidden fairway eagerly awaits a well-struck tee shot down the left hand side. No real trouble to speak of off the tee, but your second shot is very demanding in regards to club selection and accuracy. The bunker on the right side of the green is deep and well faced. This is the most difficult putting surface on the course...stay below the hole!







Hole Six

PAR 4 HCP 3/3

If any hole is played for strategic play, this is it. The smart play off the tee on this very tight landing area is a fairway metal or hybrid favoring the right side. Accuracy is a must. Players that challenge this hole with a driver may reach the small stream on the left and right side of the fairway, so think twice. The green is very receptive to a well-struck shot. The putting surface is relatively flat with a small slope from back to front.

Hole Seven

PAR 4 14CP 15/11

This very sharp dogleg right requires much thought. Longer hitters using a driver must try to carry the small group of trees lining the right side of the dogleg. A long tee shot pulled down the left side may run out of fairway and is dangerously close to the out of bounds on left side of hole. A tee shot placed in the center of the fairway will leave a downhill mid to short iron into a postage stamp size putting surface. There is a small bunker on the left side of the green and should be considered, but offers little challenge to escape from.







Hole Eight

PAR 3 14CP 7/15

Looks are deceiving. This is a very difficult Par 3. Club selection is important, but accuracy is a must. Once you have successfully avoided the bunker on the left side of putting surface the real test begins. The putting green has several levels, all of which slope severely from back to front. A very sharp shot game is a must if you miss this green.

Hole Nine

PAR 5 HCP 13/7

This slight dogleg right Par 5 has ample room for a misguided tee shot. Try to favor the right hand side of fairway. The second shot requires a bit of focus. There is a devilishly placed bunker on the right side of fairway 70 yards from the green that must be avoided. The putting surface is flanked on the left and right by deep bunkers and the elevated green has a gradual slope from back to front while rolling left to right. Over the green is next to impossible to get up and down.

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

Hole Ten

PAR 4 14CP 14/12

Very slight dogleg left. No trouble to speak of off the tee. Be careful not to run through the fairway off the tee. The approach shot with a mid to short iron should avoid the two small bunkers which guard the front left and right side of green. The putting surface is circular and flat. A great birdie opportunity.







Hole Eleven

PAR 5 14CP 6/14

A true risk/reward hole. For the long hitters favoring the right side this hole is reachable in two shots. The average player should also favor the right side of fairway, avoiding the small grouping of trees that protrude down the left side. A second shot with either fairway metal or long iron will leave a very short, yet difficult pitch shot. The green surface traverses from back to front and left to right. The bunker on the front right of the green is a popular collection area for wayward approach shots. Don't be long or left unless your short game is at it's best.







Hole Twelve

PAR 3 14CP 16/18

This hole plays a bit longer than the yardage due to the slight elevation change. Be sure to avoid the bunkers short of the putting green located on the left and right side. The large green surface slopes from front to back. Don't be too aggressive with your putt if you are above the hole.

Hole Thirteen

PAR 4 HCP 2/4

Hold your breath on this, our most difficult Par 4. Very sharp dogleg left. There is tree trouble on both left and right side of fairway. A safe play would be to hit a fairway metal or hybrid that will leave a mid to long iron into a very severe putting surface. The green is slightly elevated and any shot missing the green long or left will require a skillful flop shot to save strokes. Stay below the hole at all costs.







Hole Fourteen

PAR 5 HCP 8/6

Another challenging tee shot with trouble lurking on the left and right side of this hole. The fairway is a very demanding 90° dogleg right. The fairway comes to an abrupt end on the left, so don't be too aggressive. Your second is straight away with no real trouble. Favor the right side avoiding the small water hazard that could come into play if you are wild left. The putting green is very receptive and relatively flat. Two small bunkers frame the green on left and right side.

Hole Fifteen

PAR 3 14CP 12/16

Absolutely brutal Par 3. Be sure of your distance and choose your club wisely. Trouble is waiting on every side of green. The two large bunkers left and right are difficult to play from and if you are over the green...hold your breath. The putting surface has severe undulations moving in every direction. A three on this hole is a great achievement.

Hole Sixteen

Par 4/5 HCP 4/8

There is ample room on this slight dogleg right Par 4. Driver is a good choice from all tee areas favoring the right side of the fairway. The second shot will need to carry a water hazard that lies in the middle of the fairway about 100 yds from the green. The two bunkers on the left side of the green are difficult to recover from. The putting surface is two-tiered sloping severely from back to front. Once again...hang on tight if you are above the hole.

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Hole Seventeen

PAR 4 1-10

Finally, a rest off the tee. No real trouble to speak of on this ever so slight dogleg right. Go ahead and give it a rip off the tee. The second shot with a mid to short iron will need to miss the small hidden bunker on the front side of the green. The area surrounding the green is very forgiving and makes for an easy pitch or chip. The putting surface is small and flat and offers good chance for birdie or an easy par.

Hole Eighteen

PAR 4 1/CP 10/2

Accuracy is a must. Longer hitters are careful not to stray too far left or right off the tee. Two very small water hazards surrounded by trees flank the left and right side of the fairway. The second shot plays a bit longer due to elevation change. Two bunkers on the left and right side of green are a torment if found. The putting green is large and has a gradual slope from back to front. Long over the green is a certain bogie...beware!

- 4. Keep carts 25 feet from greens and tees.
- 5. Allow faster groups through.
- 6. Repair ball marks, rake traps and replace divots.
- 7. No personal coolers.
